Holden, a farmer in the Glenville section of Jackson County, has demonstrated that a comiuntion of vegetable production, livestick mising and poultry Tesults in one of the most profitable types of farming and gives a better distribution of labor throughout the year, says H. R. Niswonger, horticulturist with the Extension Service at State College.

Holden's total gross income in 1943 from the sale of his produce was \$2,457.96, divided in this way:

His farm consists of 104 acres, of which 45 are classed as cultivated land and 20 acres are in pasture. In 1943 he had two and a half acres in potatoes, one in cabbage, one in snap beans and three in turnips and cucumbers.

He grows most of the feed for has been authorized by the War his livestock and poultry as well as most of the food for his family. He follows a practice of crop ratation in growing his truck crops on land

Crimson clover follows corn, snup beans and other cultivated crops as a winter cover crop that is turned under in the spring and with the Experiment Station at the land is then used for some other cultivated crop.

Another rotation is the sowing livestock, poultry and eggs, \$560 - of a winter cover crop consisting 20. His cash outlay for hired labor, of eight pounds of red clover or chard grass. This crop remains on the ground for two years with one cutting for hay and the next year is turned under and planted to truck crops.


