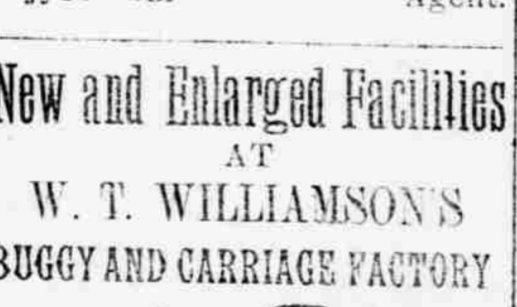

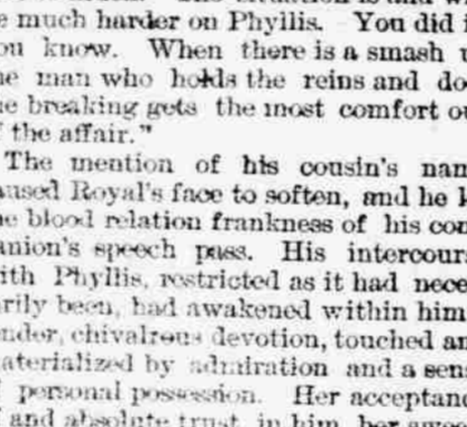
She had considered the man with whom she had gone through the ceremony as the contracting party. This subsequent declaration would change.

That Hart Royal by suppression of the fact that he was acting as proxy should have invested himself with entire responsibility as principal appeared to follow as a logical sequence.

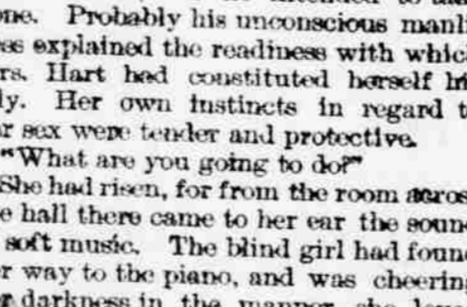
