The national debt has increased notwithstanding the vast sums that have been paid as principal, interest and premium. A careful and thorough analysis of the following statement and table is requested of the readers:

The national debt in 1789 amounted to \$2,783,000,000. We have paid on the principal of the public debt \$1,599,685,312, and as interest on same \$1,440,726,049, and a further sum of \$58,540,000 as premiums on bonds purchased, amounting in all to \$4,188,951,361. Yet we find the debt of the nation has actually increased if paid in the labor and products of the people (any person of ordinary intelligence knows it can not be paid in anything else), that is to say, it will take more labor products to pay what we now owe at present prices than it would have taken to pay the entire indebtedness in 1866 at the prices then.
