VALUE OF SHEEP ON THE FARM. No other animal eats so many different varieties of herbage as the sheep, and this fact should recommend the animals to farmers where the fields are over-run with weeds, writes E. P. Smith in the American Cultivator.

GROWING PEAS.

It has been found by careful tests that peas planted at about nine inches depth will vegetate better than at any depth less or more. Many years I pre-ferred dropping them in the furrow, never deep enough, and plowing them in. This can be done any time the ground can be worked, and in the time before sowing through the ground can be tilled to suppress weed growths.

FARM NOTES.

The importance of barn distillers should not be lost sight of. They provide drink for the stock and also prevent water from the roofs filtering through the manure, which takes away its most valuable fertilizing element. The water may be made by the use of a filter and it is better for the use of stock than water from a well.
