The following treaty, which will have to be voted on by the United States, has been drawn and accepted by the new Republic of Panama:

The United States guarantees and will maintain the independence of the Republic of Panama, and in turn is granted in perpetuity the use, occupation and control of a negro helped to put the paper on a strip ten miles wide and extending high standard.
