One Farmer Expects His Cotton to Yield Two Bags to the Acre and Corn One Hundred Bushels to the Acre.

Mr. J. A. Guy has just returned from Stedman, where he went, like many others are doing, to look at the wonderful corn and cotton crops Mr. Jeff D. Sessoms is raising. Mr. Guy says that Mr. Sessoms will average 100 bushels of corn to the acre and two bales of cotton to the acre.

The corn is planted in five foot rows, eight inches in the drill and upon him enthusiastically, embrac- the stalks average four ears aplece. The corn is now ready for pulling. The cotton is planted five feet apart, two and a half feet in the drill, and is now waist high.
