Ordinance. THE ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE DO ORDAIN, That no person having obtained license for the purpose of running any Dray or Omnibus, shall be permitted to do the same, unless having first paid his license tax; and any person violating this Ordinance shall be liable to a penalty of ten dollars, for each and every day, to be collected by the Marshal for the use of the City Treasurer, by distress or otherwise. Adopted January 28, 1869.
