

EXPECTS CLUB LINE WITHIN TWO MONTHS President Chatham Anxious That It Be Ready For Service By January 1st

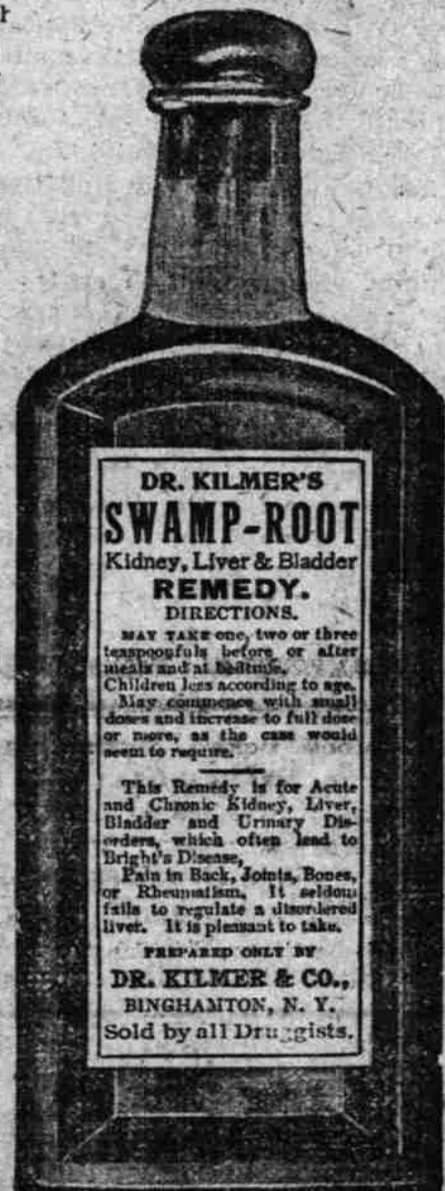
