EVENTS OF THE DAY FROM STATESVILLE

Pretty Wedding of Popular Iredell Couple—Presbyterial Conference Begins Sessions

(Special to The Chronicle.) STATESVILLE, Nov. 21.—A pretty wedding took place yesterday morning at the home of Mr. and Mrs. J. E. Hendren at Turnersburg, 12 miles from Statesville, when their daughter, Miss Jessie Hendren of Charlotte, became the bride of Mr. Jacob Edwin Griffith of Baltimore. The ceremony was performed in the parlor of the home, which was decorated for the occasion, in the presence of quite a party of friends and relatives. Dr. Charles Anderson of Statesville officiating. The ring service was used. The bride wore a wedding gown of white tulle and lace, with a long train. The bride wore a handsome coat suit of blue and carried a large white chrysanthemum bouquet. Immediately after the ceremony, the bride and groom left for Baltimore, where they will live.

The bride is a very attractive young lady of fine qualities and Mr. Griffith is fortunate in securing her for his bride. She was for a time a resident of Statesville and has many friends here who wish her happiness. Mr. Griffith is a young business man of Baltimore, who makes good impressions on short acquaintance. There were a number of friends from a distance at the wedding.

All trains are bringing delegates to the Presbyterial conference on evangelism and finance, which convened at the First Presbyterian of Statesville last night, and it is expected that the number of delegates will reach nearly 100. Atkinson, Albemarle; "Conference on Evangelistic Campaign," Rev. Dr. A. A. McGeachy. There will be several other discussions and addresses.

The delegates to the conference are being met at the depot by a committee and transported in automobiles to the homes where they are to be entertained.
