THIRTY-FIVE FOUND TO BE GERM-LADEN

With further cultures made in the city health department's laboratory, the number of children excluded from school as diphtheria carriers has been increased to 35, Dr. McPhaul said Saturday. Over 5,000 children were inspected recently by members of the health department staff and private physicians in cases of diphtheria carriers. The action was not due to possibilities of a diphtheria epidemic but as a precautionary measure to keep children from having the disease. The 35 children found germs in their throat are regarded as immune from diphtheria but the germs can spread with ease to other children who would become easily infected, the health officer explained. After treatment to destroy the germs the children will be re-admitted to school.

TWO MEN CHARGED WITH STEALING CAR

L. E. Kersey and W. W. Vannoy, young white men, were brought before Charlotte from Salisbury Saturday. Sergeant W. H. Pitts following the arrest there Friday night for the theft of an Apperson automobile belonging to Dr. J. P. Matthews in this city. The machine was stolen Wednesday night. Notices of the theft were broadcast over the country by the police department, and Friday night a telephone message from the chief of police of Salisbury announced the capture of the car there and the arrest of the two men.
