COAL OPERATORS ARERESPONSIBLE
 Pay Salaries of Deputy Sheriffs, Interpreting the Law as Needed.
 ashington, Sept. 22.—The great by which coal operators in the Virginia fields pay the salaries of deputy sheriffs was held to be the principal cause of complaint from the miners and to be largely responsible for the recent mine disorders, in a statement made last night to the Senate investigating committee in Charleston, the Attorney General declared the public on return today of the committee to Washington.
 Called in to give the committee views, the Attorney General declared that, while the law specifically prohibited such employment, it provided a penalty and consequently was largely unenforced. The opinion was expressed by the Attorney General that the committee should start a march to Logan, sought to intimidate the authorities into calling a special session of the Legislature around the statute against which the committee complained.
 Going deeply into the deputy sheriff system, the committee found that the deputies were duly commissioned by the court and their salaries paid out of funds obtained from an assessment of the operators of 10 cents a ton of coal taken from the mines.
 The Attorney General said he was ployed to a fact that deputies were being employed in Logan county to keep the mines operating. He said that he was also a fact, he said, that the law did not prohibit men entering the regions to urge organization by the miners so long as they did not create an order.
