### THE RAPE OF THE SOUTH.

Republicans at Work to Steal the Votes of the Southern People.

WASHINGTON, April 26.-The committee selected by the Republican House caucus to consider and report to the caucus whether it should undertake to pass the national election laws on the lines of the Lodge bill or should provide for an extension of the supervising system, had a meeting today to begin the consideration of the subject. Several members of the committee were absent, so action today was confined to the decision to prepare bills embodying the two views as a basis for selection at a subsequent meet-

ing Mr. Rowell, who is chairman of the elections committee, will frame the bill to extend the supervisory system, and Mr. Lodge will prepare the national election bill and, acting under instructions, will eliminate from his original bill the provision for the adoption of the Australian system of voting, leaving the different State laws in effect, and will also modify the bill so as to make its provisions of general application lanta, Ga. without requiring any specified number of voters to petition there for.
