The House Committee on Military Affairs have reported to the House the appropriation bill for the support of the Military Academy for the fiscal year 1893 The total appropria tion carried by the bill is \$486,635, being \$67,685 less than the recommendations or estimates, and increase of \$8,471 over the appropriation for the current fiscal year. The committee and 25 in its report on the bill says that the permanent improvements included in the bill consist almost entirely of an enlargement to the gas plants, improving and modernizing the plumbing and sewerage of the posts. new sinks and bathrooms for cadets, furnishing new gymnasium, and other improvements of a permanent character. In their anxiety to reduce the amount of the bill as for as possible the committee have also reduced all salaries which exceed \$1,000 per annum, except salaries which are fixed by law.
