Louisiana Democrats Agree

NEW ORLEANS, La., Feb. 20.—The conference committee representing the two factions of the Louisiana Democrats, came to an agreement by which the two tickets for State officers nominated in Baton Rouge, in December last shall be submitted to a vote of the white Democrats of the State east at primary election, the ticket receiving the largest number of votes to be declared the regular Democratic ticket, and voted as such at the general election in April next, and the other to be withdrawn. This proposition originated with the Foster faction. It has already been accepted and ratified by the McEnery faction but the Foster faction will not declare its position upon it until this afternoon. The agreement also provides the selection of a State central committee to supersede the rival bodies now in existence. The conference committee meet again to-day and will regard certain propositions to be ratified. The date of the primaries will be set far enough off to give both parties an opportunity of making a vigorous campaign.

The Weather

The following synopsis of the weather prevailing in this country today: The storm conditions obtain in the Mississippi valley and in the Gulf States, which have prevailed since early January. The center of the depression is located in Texas, and heavy convective rains have occurred during the last twenty-four hours and there it extends over the entire country. In the northern part of the map reporting clear weather prevailing. Palestine, Texas, and Memphis, Tenn., report the following heavy rainfalls: 3.00 and 2.70 inches, respectively, while Meridian, Miss., closely follows with 1.22 inch.

NEW YORK, Feb. 20.—A dispatch received here this morning from London says that the storms that have prevailed in Great Britain almost completely prostrated the land telegraph lines. Communication between London and Liverpool and cable stations on the coast is of a fitful character and telegraph business is seriously impeded. There is however, no trouble in cabling to Germany, far east or South America by way of Europe as those sections are reached by other connections of the cables than those prostrated.

Whitlaw Reed's Resignation

A Paris dispatch to-day says: It is stated by the Gaulois that Mr. Whitlaw Reed, the American minister, has resigned and will leave Paris February 27. State Department officials discredit the report. They say that while it is not improbable that he will resign before his official term is up he has not as yet done so, nor is it at all likely that he will leave his post while there is a prospect of a satisfactory conclusion of pending negotiations for a reciprocity treaty between the United States and France.
