# **LEGISLATION PROPOSED** BY ANTI-SALOON LEAGUE

# Reforms Instituted in This State Anent Sale of Liquor

Raleigh, N. C., Jan. 7.-The followng are the features of the temperance egislation proposed by the Executive Committee of the North Carolina Anti-Saloon League in session with authorized representatives of the North Carolina Methodist Conference and the

Baptist State Convention: 1. Prohibition of sale or manufacure of intoxicating liquors outside of incorporated towns. Prohibtion of sale of liquor in towns of less than 500 population, whether incorporated or not. Prohibition of manufacture of iquors in towns of less than 1,000 popdation, whether incorporated or not. The distinction is made between in-

corporated towns and unincorporated communities because incorporated towns are organized and policed. It is made also to protect the rural districts from the saloon. It is made also to protect the towns and cities from being surrounded by saloons. The distinction is made in respect to population mainly to prevent the evasion of the law by the incorporation of saloon or distillery settlements.

2. Local Option elections in incorqualified voters; provided elections in two years.




