

Market Reports

(Reports Received by Private Wire by Howell & Dodsworth.)

New York, Aug. 14.—C. W. Lee and Co. say: Whether due to the cotton corner or to the wonderful crop accounts on the one hand and the dearth of cotton supplies on the other speculation in the market had dwindled to the smallest proportions of the season. The market this week has not only been dull, lifeless and uninteresting, but there was that element of apathy and deadness about it that furnished ample evidence of the general disposition on the part of those most interested to undertake obligations of any character. Not only commission houses, but professional traders, have withdrawn from trade for the time being, and the one hand crop accounts and general disposition of the plant are such as to prevent aggressive support or any attempt to buy cotton for higher prices. On the other hand the knowledge that the men control the present supply of cotton and owing to the lateness of the season it will be some weeks before enough cotton can be obtained to supply the demand of European spinners prevents any attempt to sell short for a decline in prices. The net result of this condition of affairs is that prices have failed to advance or recede. The best traders on floor are almost unanimous as to the probable course of the market. Until something happens to clear the situation, the market will probably continue in the present cautious attitude and only buy on a decline and sell for quick profits of the week. The report of the spinning of new cotton in southern Texas. On Wednesday ten bales were accounted for and on Thursday fifteen or twenty more. This is the first cotton to be spun before the end of the week. Cotton spinning will be generally under way in the southern counties of Texas. It will spread rapidly until the cotton will begin to come into the various markets of the South in hundreds and thousands of bales. Realizing that it is extremely doubtful whether there will be an important and radical change in the procrastinating attitude of the American spinner. It is highly improbable that consumers will buy at 12 and 13 cents from those in control of the spot cotton market. Last year's crop was dropped when holding off a few weeks or more they will be able to get an unlimited quantity at 2 cents a pound lower. The selling of that kind would be extremely unbusinesslike and should not be attempted. Under the circumstances the cotton grower to be more interested in the market. The situation of the cotton market is extremely nervous. Under the circumstances an extremely cautious and conservative attitude on the part of consumers is to be expected and its future more than usually uncertain.
