The bill relative to the appointment of guardians was reported without prejudice and after extended debate on a substitute offered by Senator London, of Chatham, final action was deferred.

The bill requiring medical and surgical appliances to be kept in factories was reported favorably by the committee on public health, but objection being raised it went over until next Friday.

The bill to extend the privilege of free transportation by common carriers of this state to common carriers of other states passed second reading and on objection by Senator Pharr went over until Monday.

Action was deferred on the bills raising the age limit for working on the roads from 18 to 21 years, amend the charter of Salem and regarding the speed of automobiles in Wayne coun-

A conference committee was appointed on the bill prohibiting throwing sawdust in the streams of Yadkin county.
