Atlanta, Oct. 25.—Unusual interest is being manifested in the hearing of the contest over the will of the late Major J. F. Hanson, president of the Central of Georgia Railway, which began here this morning. Contestants of the will are seeking to prevent its being probated on allegations charging fraud and misrepresentation.

The deposition of Mrs. Cora LeLe Hanson, widow of Major Hanson, reciting the story of their marital differences is the feature of the depositions that will form the testimony in the case.

STABLE MAN MURDERED CAPITALIST.

San Jose, Cal., Oct. 25.—Simon Romero, a capitalist, was killed and Miss Helen Quezada, daughter of Francisco Quezada, a millionaire planter of Costa Rica, was wounded early today by Manuel Garcia, a stable man. Miss Quezada had reprimanded him for riding her thoroughbred horse with out permission.

Miss Quezada's life was probably saved by Mrs. Amparo Zeledon, of Costa Rica, a guest at the Quezada home who jumped on the murderer's back as he fired at the girl, aiming his revolver. Garcia escaped and a posse started in pursuit.

Jailed At Union on Murder Charge

Tartor General Was Assassinated

By Associated Press. Canton, China, Oct. 25.—The newly appointed Tartar general, Fung Sen, was assassinated upon his arrival to assume his duties today. The general accompanied by his wife and a large escort of soldiers were coming ashore when a bomb thrown from the roof of a building dropped among the party. The explosion that followed killed Fung Sen and a number of soldiers and caused a fire that burned several houses. According to one account the general's wife was killed. They came here from Shanghai, having stopped a few days at Hong Kong.
