The Cubans are well organized and their army is equipped with all the latest improved army rifles, machine guns, etc., and it is believed that they could place 40,000 to 30,000 well drilled soldiers in the field on a few hours' notice. The Cubans fight principally from ambush and so well do they know the location of the big cane brakes of the island that it is almost impossible to oust them when they once get entrenched among the fight unto death.
