

ANNOUNCEMENTS FOR FALL QUARTER 1949 AT CHARLOTTE COLLEGE

The faculty and student government of Charlotte College welcome into its student body all returning students and all students entering this quarter. It is the purpose of the College to have a highly successful year.

FOR YOUR ASSISTANCE:

1. Information may be secured from the office concerning full and part-time employment and living quarters for students.

2. Library containing about 10,000 volumes is located on the third floor of the building. The library opens for the use of college students at 3 P. M. and remains open until the close of classes. Encyclopedias, magazines, and reference books are not to be taken from the library. Books put on reserve by teachers may be charged out for overnight use, but must be returned the following day. Failure to do this incurs a fine of five cents. All other books may be charged out for two weeks. The librarian may call in a book at any time to place it on a teacher reserve shelf. A fine of two cents a day will be charged on all overdue books other than reserve. A student holding a book at the end of the quarter will not receive credit for any work done until the book is returned. If the book has been lost, some arrangements must be made with the office.

3. Room 315 will be provided for group study.

FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE:

1. The book store on the first floor opens each day. Watch the bulletin board for the time. Veterans can purchase paper and pencils on the G. I. Bill.

2. Books will be available at the college office during the first two weeks of school. All books should be secured during the first two weeks of school. All books should be secured during that time.
