ANOTHER MURDER

In Rowan County-Some Relation to mr. Joel Reid, of This City.

Hardly has the talk ceased of the killing affair at the Rowan county chain geng until we see from the official labors, dalisbury papers that there has still been another one, which was committed near Manney's mill, in the eastern part of the county. The man killed was Mr. Milas Reid, adjustments for failure of service. whose father is a nephew of M'. Wm. Reid, of Salisbury, and also of Mr. Joel Reid, of this city. The circumstances of the murder seem to be that Mr. Reid was returning home from his father's house and was closely followed by one Thomas Broadaway, a notoriously in the direction of Smith's Grove, bad character, and when Reid was near his home Breadaway pulled a piscol and fired two shots at him. At the firing of the second shot get to him he was dead. Mr. Reid was about twenty five years of age, and leaves a wife and one child.
