AN ATTEMPTED ASSAULT.

Some Person Enters the Room of Mrs. David Blackwelder of Our County—A Shameful Affair—A Negro Stands Trial and is Sent to Jail

On Wednesday night, the 28th, a crime was committed in our county which will no doubt make a big trial at the coming term of court. It is a case of attempted assault on the wife of Mr. David Blackwelder, of No. 6 townsh p. It is a bad affair and we will only state it in as few words as possible gained from the trial in the court room today (Saturday) before Esquires U. A. Pitts and Addison Crowell.

On Wednesday night about 11 o'clock some one entered the room of Mrs. Blackwelder and attempted the crime. Her throat bore demarcations. Her husband was away from home that night. She screamed and called the name of a negro, Charles Barringer, who sleeps in the kitchen near-by. The man jumped from the window hurriedly, and the negro responded to the call, as also did a young man, Robt. Goodman who lived near there. The negro who slept in the kitchen is the accused one and was arrested between midnight and daybreak and brought here for trial. The woman testifies that she believes he is the one, but her vision was somewhat obscured. The community succeeded in keeping the matter quiet until they could gain their evidence. The negro, though, worked for Mr. Blackwelder Thursday and Friday.

In default of a \$500 bond the negro was confined to jail to await court.
