Would Debate With 】annai if the Latter is Really the Presidential Candidate.
:We suppose as a måster of the art of rotort Mr. Bryan hardly has a revival among our 'public
men of today.

The following was gotten off few days ago at Fort Worth wher he was making a speech: Mr. Bryan's attention was called to a speech made at.Del phia, Ind., by Senator Hanna, chairman of the Republican na tional cominittee, in which the Senator was quoted as saying he was ready to debate "imperial ism" with Mr. Bryan or any other Democrat. In reply to the question whether he would ac cept a challenge from Hanna Mr. Bryan said:
"I know nothing of the mat papers. The challenge has no been received and I would not accept it if it were. While would be glad to debate public questions with the Republican candidate for the presidency, I would not be willing to debate less than my own. If I elected I shall be president. If the Republican committee will certiify that Mr. Hanna is to be president, in case of Republican success, I shall willingly meet him in joint debate."
Mr. Bryan was elso asked if he had anything to say in reply to Mr. Hanna's charge that he was i-frenced by sinisier mo ves in securing the ratificatio of the treaty with Spain. T this he replied: "I have give my reasons for believing it bet er to ratify the treaty and de lare the nation's policy by reso lution, and the voters hare an pporiunity to pass judgmen upon my reasons. I must con fess, however that Mr. Hanna is an exper't when he discusse s'nister motives, but I can slan his criticism it Senator Hoar can endure his praise.
