Premier's Promise of Indemnities to Be Kept By Conference, or "Some One Has Sold the Pass."

London.-The view that the terms of peace with Germany should be settled before the organization of a society of nations is dealt with was expressed in the house of commons by Horatio W. Bottomley. The preliminary treaty, he said,

should be initiated and then submitted to the peoples of each country. Mr. Bottomley said he was not sure that if that were done, President Wilson would find that he spoke with such absolute authority for the United States. He said he supposed that in any case President Wilson on his return to America would find American idealism taking a very practical form in securing food contracts throughout the world and "scooping the pool while we are talking about

If there had been no disagreement at the peace conference as had been said in the king's speech, Mr. Bottomley added, then the question of the freedom of the seas had gone, the dominions were to be supreme regarding the German colonies and the premier's promise as to indemnities were to be carried out, or "some one has sold the pass."

Washington.-The bolshevik regime in Russia was described by Rev. G. A. Simons, in testimony before the senate committee investigating lawless agitation in the United States, as a minority military dictatorship supported by terrorism. Dr. Simons, who for many years has been head of the Methodist Episcopal church in Russia, said most of the bolshevik leaders were Jews, many from the Eastside of New York, and that they had set aside large sums for the spread of their doctrine in all the countries of the world.
