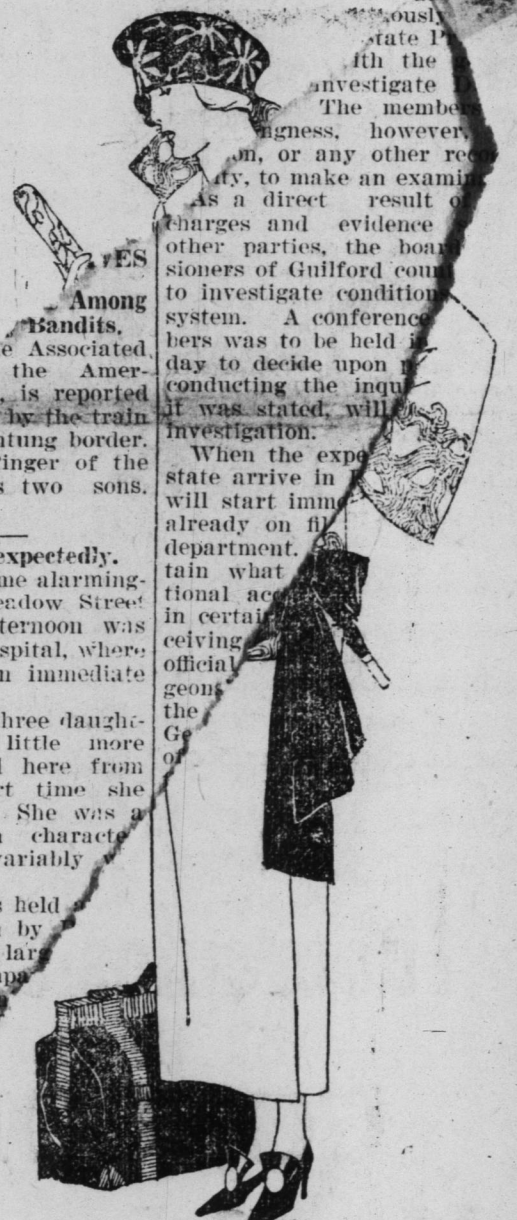

### American Killed by the Bandits.

Shanghai, May 7.—An American was killed by the bandits who held up the Shanghai-Peking express train near Shantung border and carried off 150 prisoners early yesterday, according to a message from Nieneng, but all of the women captives including Miss Lucy Aldrich, sister-in-law of John D. Rockefeller, Jr., have been released. The men still held are said to be in grave danger.

The message said the bandits had notified the authorities that all the men among the foreign captives would be killed unless the troops are withdrawn.

Miss McFadden and Miss Coralli were released with Miss Aldrich, the report added. Troops were pressing the bandits on both sides at latest advices.
