NEGRO ASSAILANTS OF THOMPSON ARE STILL AT LIBERTY

Police Officers Throughout State Have Been Asked to Watch For Men Who Robbed Man Here Yesterday.

Local police officers have received no information that might lead to the arrest of the two negroes who at noon yesterday assaulted and robbed H. O. Thompson, manager of a filling station here.

Police officers believe the assault on Thompson was made about 12 o'clock yesterday. Several persons who were unloading a truck near the filling station, declared that they saw him at the station at 11:50.

When Thompson told his sister in a cheerful manner of the attack on him she called other relatives. Thompson was able to talk to them in a dazed manner for several minutes but later he fainted and was not able to answer any questions until late in the afternoon.
