

NEWSPAPER LAWS.

1. Subscribers who do not have express notices to the contrary, are considered as wishing to continue their subscriptions.

2. If subscribers order the discontinuance of their periodicals, the publishers may continue to send them until all arrearages are paid.

3. If subscribers neglect or refuse to take their periodicals from the office to which they are directed, they are responsible until they have notified the publishers and ordered them discontinued.

4. If subscribers move to other places, without informing the publishers, and the papers are sent to the former addresses, they are held responsible.

5. Any person who receives a newspaper and makes use of it, whether he has ordered it or not, is held in law to be a subscriber.

6. If subscribers pay in advance, they are bound to give notice to the publisher at the end of their time, if they do not wish to continue taking the paper, otherwise the publisher is authorized to send it on, and the subscriber will be responsible until express notice with payment of all arrears, is sent to the publisher.
