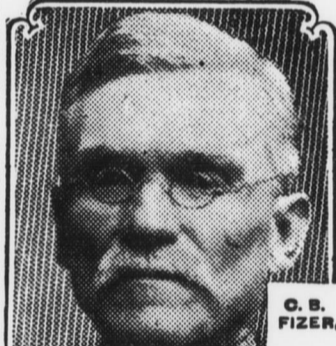
**Card of Thanks.**

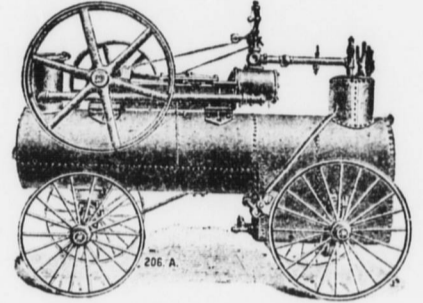
