KILLED FOR HIS MONEY.

Dead Body of Cullen Powell of Warsaw Found By Road.

Goldsboro, N. C.—Mr. Cullen Powell a prominent farmer of Warsaw was found dead on the county road Sunday. A coroner's jury Sunday morning held its sitting in the court room in the Edgerton building. Three suspects were arrested, these being John Stobbs, Lem Pigford and Jim Franklin, all white men. Pigford was released later as there was no evidence to hold him, but the other two are being held until the murder can be more fully investigated by officers.
