## The Farmer's Automobile.

The automobile is doing much to alter the daily life of the cities. It will do more in time to alter the daily life of the rural sections. The Postoffice Department is trying some experiments with the automobile for the purpose of quickening the rural delivery and improving the postal facilities. The Postmaster General reports that a carrier with an automobile can serve a route of at least fifty miles and serve it better than is now done by the ordinary wagons on a route of twenty-five miles.

The automobile is in use on over four hundred of the experimental routes. It was intro-

duced only after recommendation by postmasters or inspectors where road and weather conditions will admit of the use of the motor vehicles at least nine months in the year. In the South it ought to admit of the use all the year round. The authorities report that the success of the automobile service has been fully demonstrated.

We refer to this in the hope of enforcing upon our farmers, not indulgence in any extravagance, but the consideration of the use of the automobile as a means of economy in transportation. It is essential that the farmer get his produce to the nearest town or the nearest railroad station at the least possible cost.—Home and Farm.
