

"LIVE AT HOME" MOVEMENT STARTS

Effort Will Be Made To Induce North Carolina People To Grow Supplies At Home.

Raleigh, March 4.—A definite start is being made this week in the work of putting over Governor Cameron Morrison's "Live at Home" campaign.

During the campaign emphasis will be laid not upon the production of food supplies for the market, but upon the production by every family of food and feed

supplies sufficient to supply its own establishment. More and better gardens, more poultry, one or more cows for each family, and sufficient hogs to furnish an all-year supply of pork will be advocated.

The campaign which is being inaugurated will be intensively conducted and will cover a period of eight or ten weeks.
