Frank King, who has been working here on the store building of N. A. Martin, is confined to his home in Stoneville with sickness.

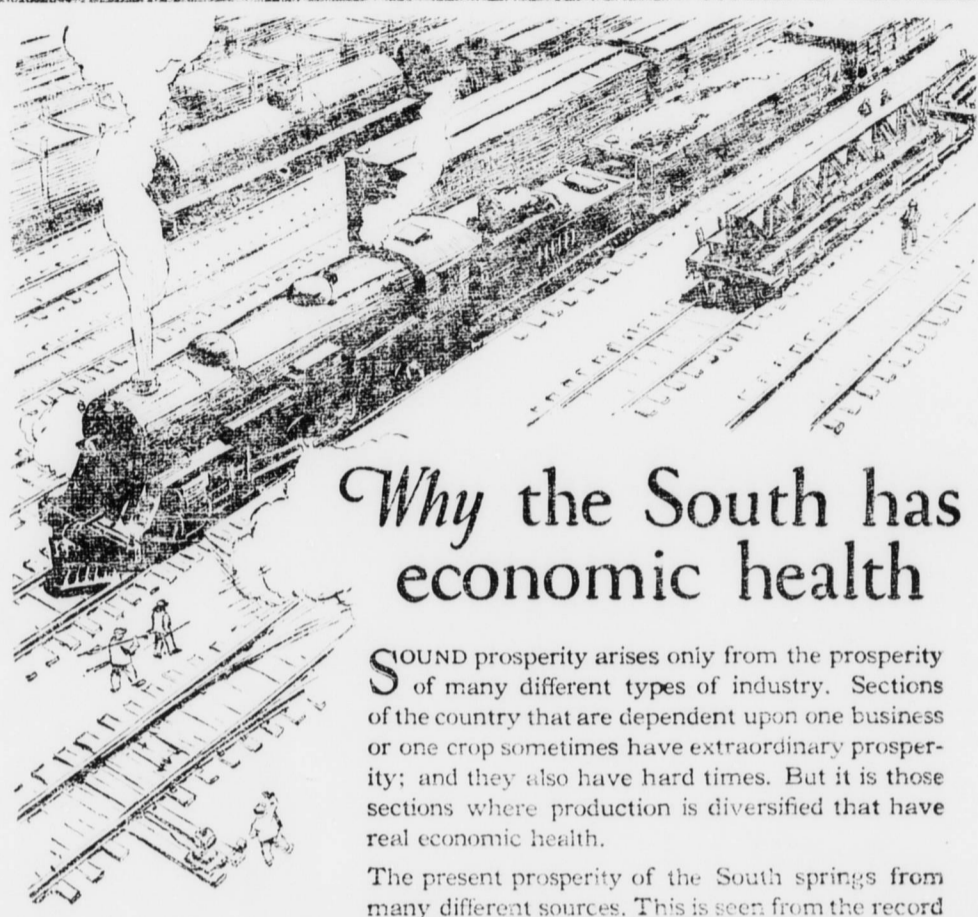
Farmers Meet In Raleigh July 27-29
