State College Answers Timely Farm Questions

Question: Please give me the dates of Farm and Home Week at State College this summer. I have seen two different dates announced.

Answer: Farm and Home

Week will be held August 2 to 6, Monday through Friday. Delegates should register Monday, August 2, as the opening exercises will be held Monday evening in Riddick Stadium. Rooms in the college dormitories will be assigned free to visitors as long as space is available. After that, visitors may secure rooms nearby the campus at a nominal price. John W. Goodman is general secretary of Farm and Home Week and those desiring information about the program should write to him at State College.

Question: How can I prevent the spread of mosaic in my tobacco fields?

Answer: Extreme care should be taken in topping, worming and suckering the plants. Avoid handling the diseased plants until all the healthy plants have been cared for. Roguing out the diseased plants will also check the spread. To be most effective this should be done before

each cultivation. The removal of these plants will prevent the spread by implements used in cultivation. After the diseased plants are removed the hands and all clothing should be carefully cleaned before additional work is done in the field.

Question: What steps can be taken to prevent infestation of my chickens with worms?

Answer: There is no method that will guarantee the absolute elimination of worms, but the worm hazard can be reduced to a minimum if the ranges are kept free from low areas that hold moisture for a long period of time and if the breeding places for immediate hosts such as snails, dung beetles and house flies are destroyed. The dropping boards should be screened and when cleaned the droppings should be removed far enough from the range so the birds cannot get to them. It is also well to plow up the ranges used for rearing chicks

each year and sow this in a good grazing crop. If these precautions are taken the worm infestation will be reduced to a minimum.
