JUST AS USUAL

There are some things we don't understand, there are other things we don't and there are a few things we do understand, but we don't understand the ways of our County Commissioners in giving out the county statement for publication.

Take for instance, on last first Monday. We submitted a sealed bid offering to publish it for price allowed by law, and asked that our circulation be considered in awarding the contract. We, as has for some time been the custom, submitted a sealed bid. Mr. Whichard went before them and simply asked them to let him publish it at price allowed by law. And he got it.

The circulation of the Weekly is 2,250 twice a week. To use the common local expression, "everybody takes it." Our books are always open to the business public. We have never heard of anyone knowing Mr. Whichard's circulation and we defy him to show one-third of 2,250. Circulation is the only basis of estimating cost in such matters.

We have been running the Weekly now very, very nearly seven years, and it had been established nearly a year when we bought it. Each year, when given a chance, we have always put in a bid for publishing the county statement. EACH TIME OUR BID HAS BEEN THE LOWEST. EACH TIME WE GOT IT NOT.

In these seven years we have saved the county perhaps \$300 by bidding, causing the work to be done cheaper. The Code (1883) fixed the price at not to exceed one-half of a cent a word. Yet in the face of this, county attorneys at \$300 a year, with little else to do, have let their pet be paid three or more times that rate. Before we began bidding for it, the county paid over \$100 for it. Now it is much less than half that sum, though we have never been able to find out exactly what was paid.

Now we say that we have been treated unfair in these matters as well as in many others. It is nothing but fair to divide up favors. That is democracy. But alas, there is little democracy in Pitt county now. It is Boss-ocracy, with a great big B.

But these things will not always continue. THE PEOPLE MUST AND WILL RULE.
