CHIEF JUSTICE CLARK ANNOUNCES FOR SENATE

Outlines Platform, Advocating Election of Senators by People---Also Election of District Federal Judges and Postmasters.

Raleigh, May 17.-Chief Justice Walter Clark, of the North Carolina Su-reme Court, announced tonight his candissev for the United States Senate against Senator Simmons and Governor

He outlines a platform that declares that the ruling of the United States Supreme Court in the Standard Oil case shifts the arena for the control of trusts from the courts to the United States Senate where the anti-trust laws must be amended. The people, he says, not control the House of Representatives.

He declares himself a progressive Democrat, which, he insists, is simply Jeffersonian Democracy. He advocates tariff for revenue only, constitutional amendments that will elect United States Senators by the people and federal judges by the people of the districts they serve, the election of postmasters by the people of the territory served. declares for "Initiative and referendum" and recall for such officers as by law may be provided.

He advocates a Democratic primary the same day all over the state to nominate state officers and United States Senator under restrictions that will assure publicity as to the money expended. a second primary to be held for Senator.


