

# THE OFFICIAL LIST FOR PITT COUNTY'S FIRST 672 MEN

The following is a correct list of the names of the first 672 men of Pitt county who will be called before the local exemption board to stand examination for the new army.

As soon as the local board receives official orders, these men will be summoned in order, probably in batches of 224 at a time. The examinations will begin some day next week and will be rushed until the required quota of 336 men have been secured. If these cannot be secured out of the 672 names, then others will be called in the order in which they were drawn out until the required quota is secured.

This list is tabulated from the official master list furnished by the government and is correct. Some names that were published by mistake in the first list have been removed, and some that were not published have been added.

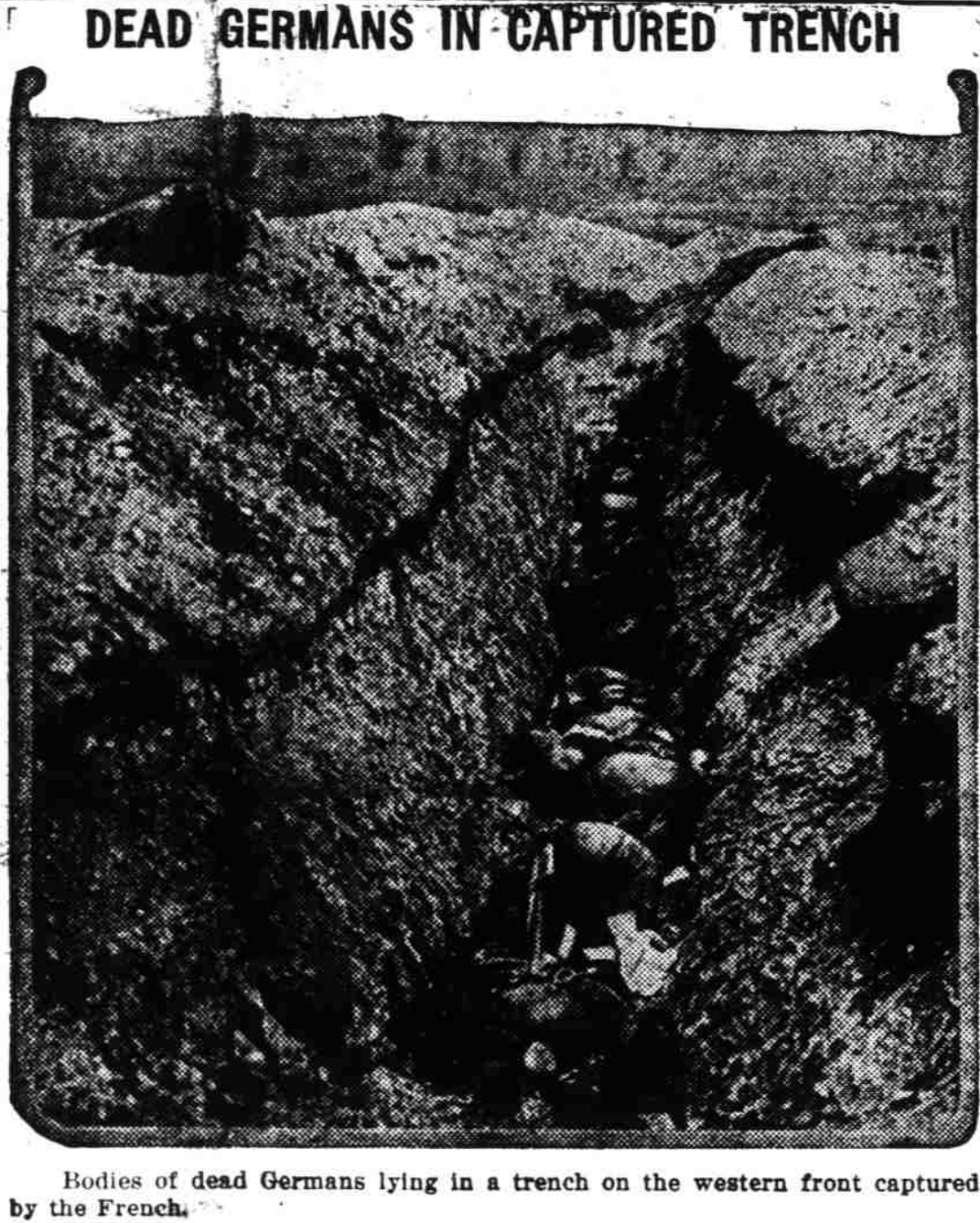

C., in that it tells of his having inherited some \$20,000 from an aunt in Meredith, New Hampshire. Following a wire announcement of the bare fact, this paper sent a telegram asking for the full facts. The following is the reply received this morning:

"Athol, Mass.  
"To Greenville Daily News,  
"Greenville, N. C.  
"An estimate of the estate of the late Thos. H. Goodspeed, a local banker, is placed at \$28,000. It is estimated that the personal property amounts to \$24,000 and \$4,000 in real estate. The will provides that two-thirds of the estate shall go to James H. Mayo of Greenville, N. C., who is a nephew of Mrs. Goodspeed, and one-third to James A. Gold, of Minneapolis, Minn., a cousin of Mrs. Goodspeed.

"Both these men are named as executors. In the first clause of the will Mr. Goodspeed states that he did not care to leave any of the estate to his own relatives. His only sister resides in Brattleboro, Vermont.

### Russian Women as Army Regulars Fighting Hard

PETROGRAD.—"Drilling daily in the rain and mud, quartered no better than the lowest private, asking no favors but to be allowed to fight on equal terms with the men against the enemy, and braving at first the sneers and jeers of the male fighters, the Russian women's 'Legion of Death' has proved in the supreme test that there is a place for women in the fighting line."

That is the opinion of Rheta Childe Dorr, the American suffragist and newspaper writer, when she returned to Petrograd after a visit of two weeks with the first women fighters ever attached to a modern army.
