

Assassin's Victim



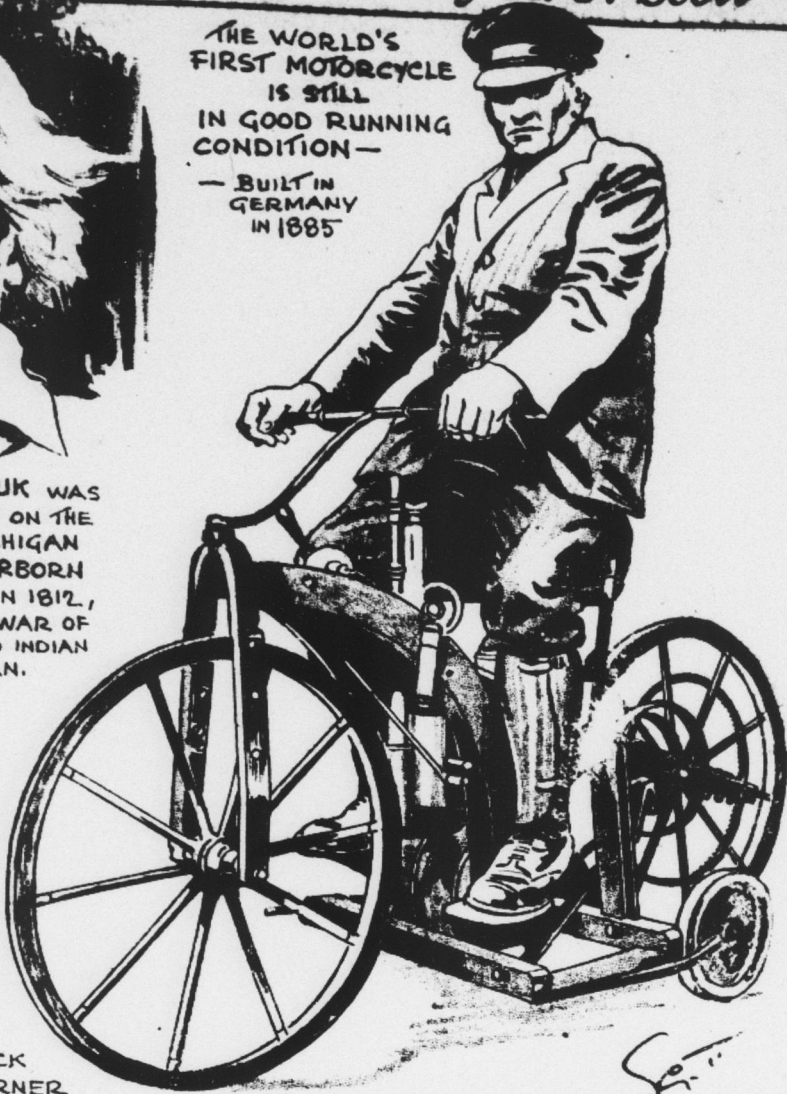

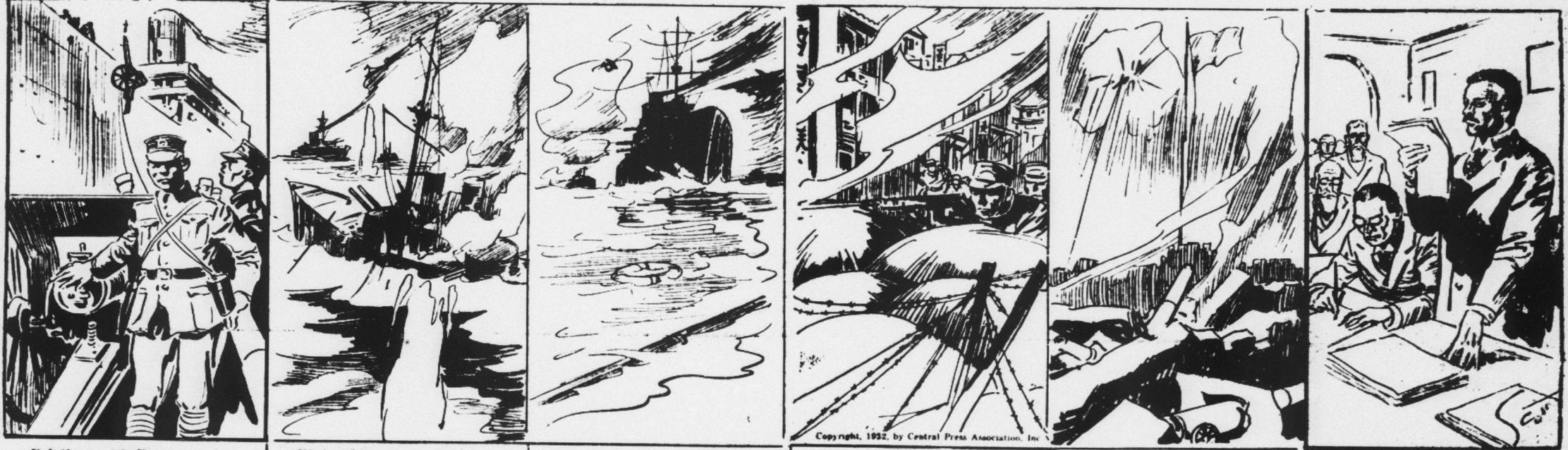

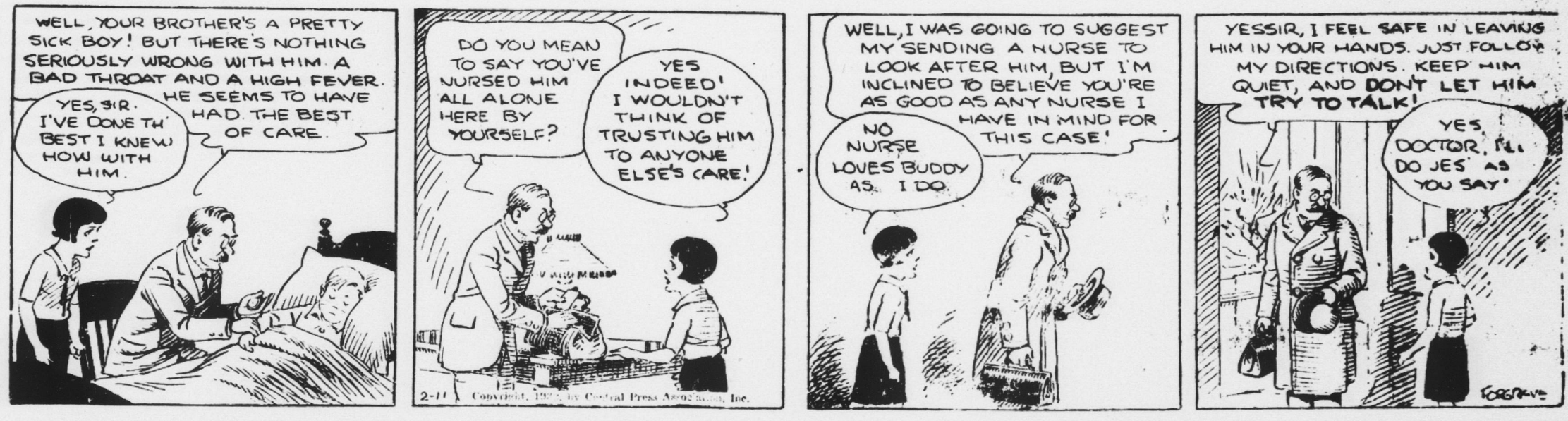
