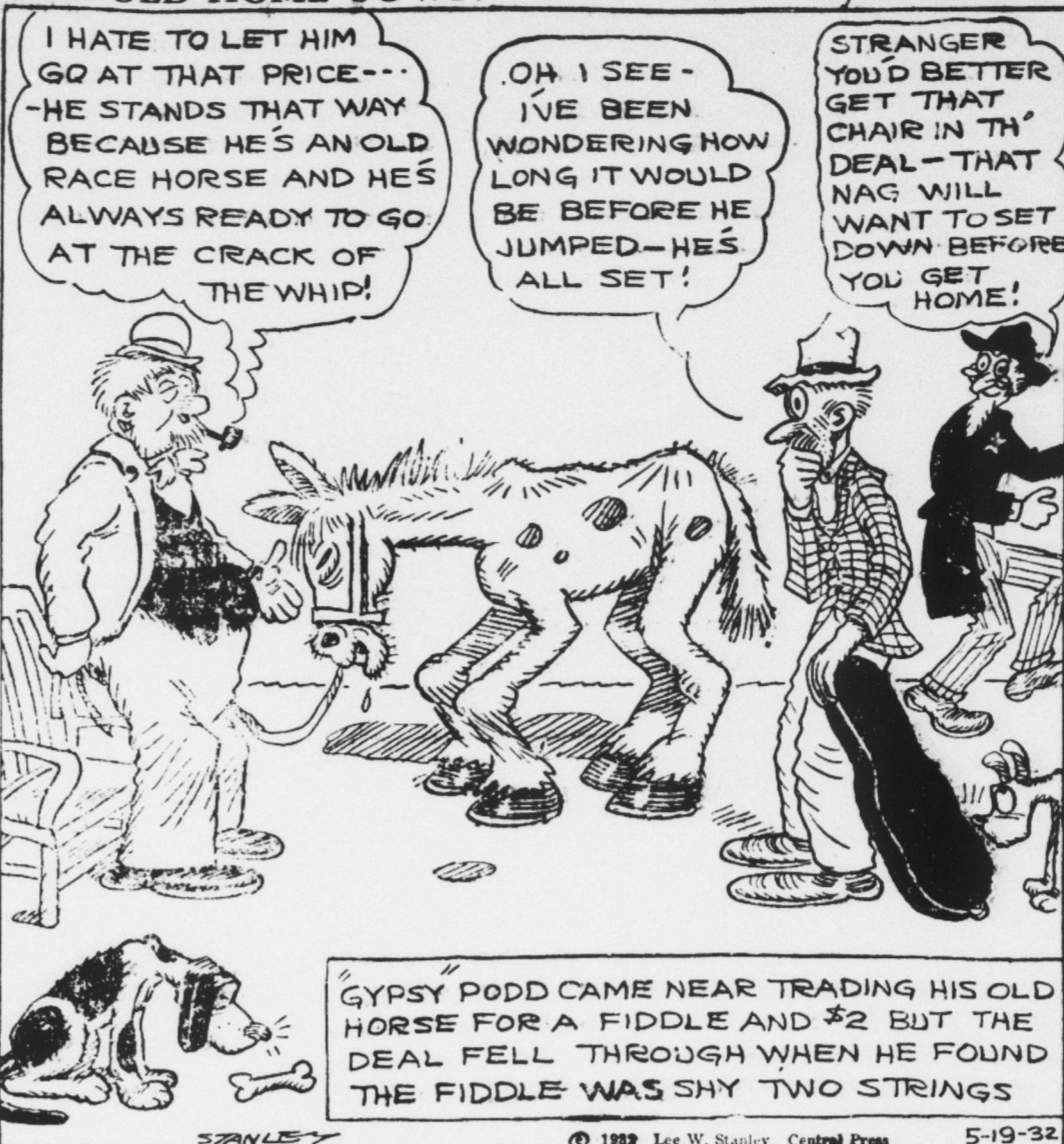

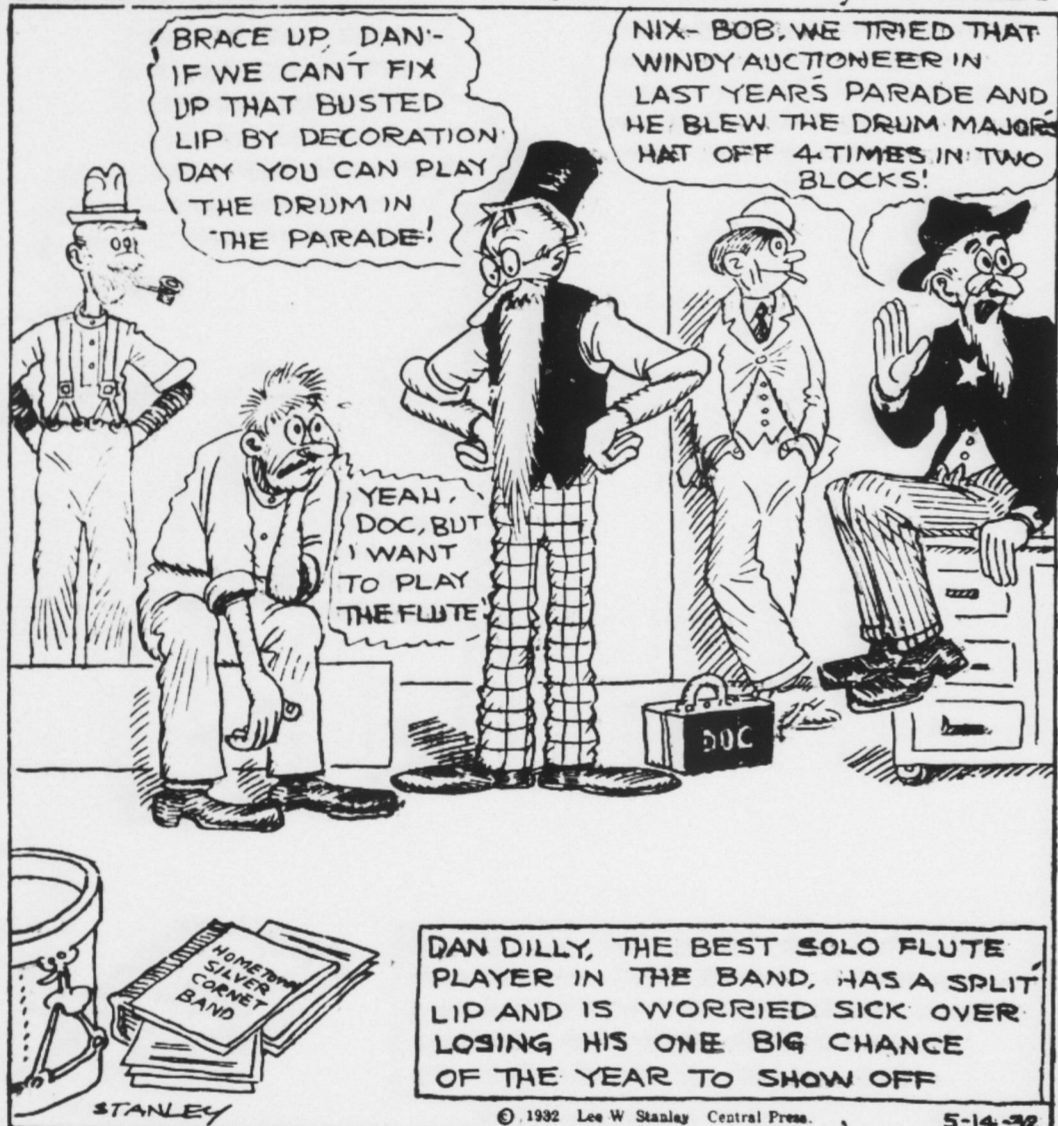
- 1809 THE EMBARGO ACT IS REPEALED AND A NON-IMPORTATION ACT IS PASSED

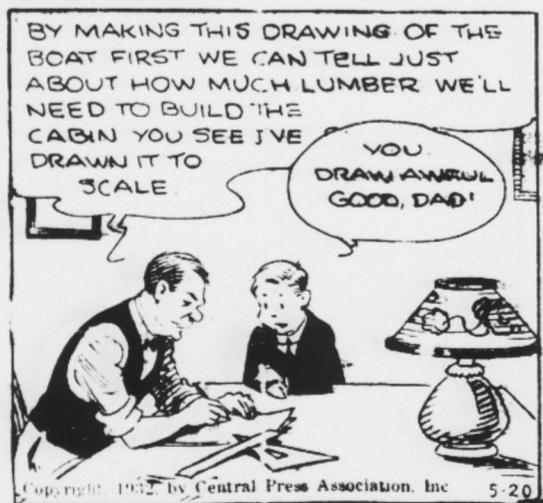

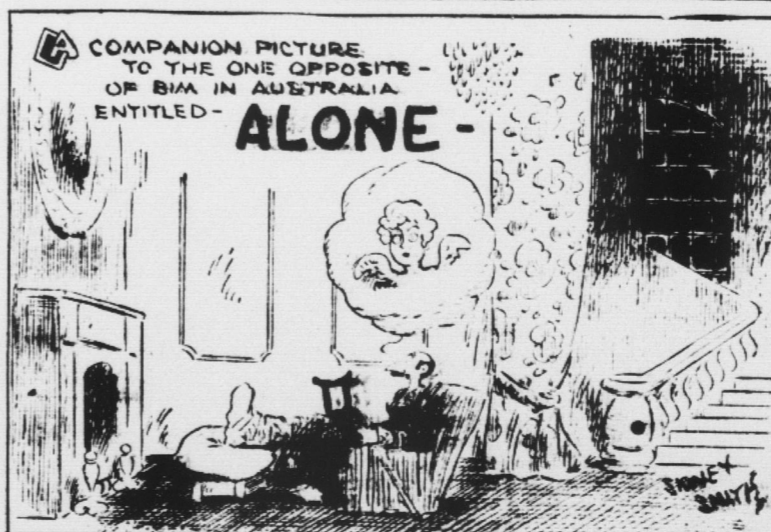
