

WINTER PEAS, VETCH PLANTED IN DUPLIN

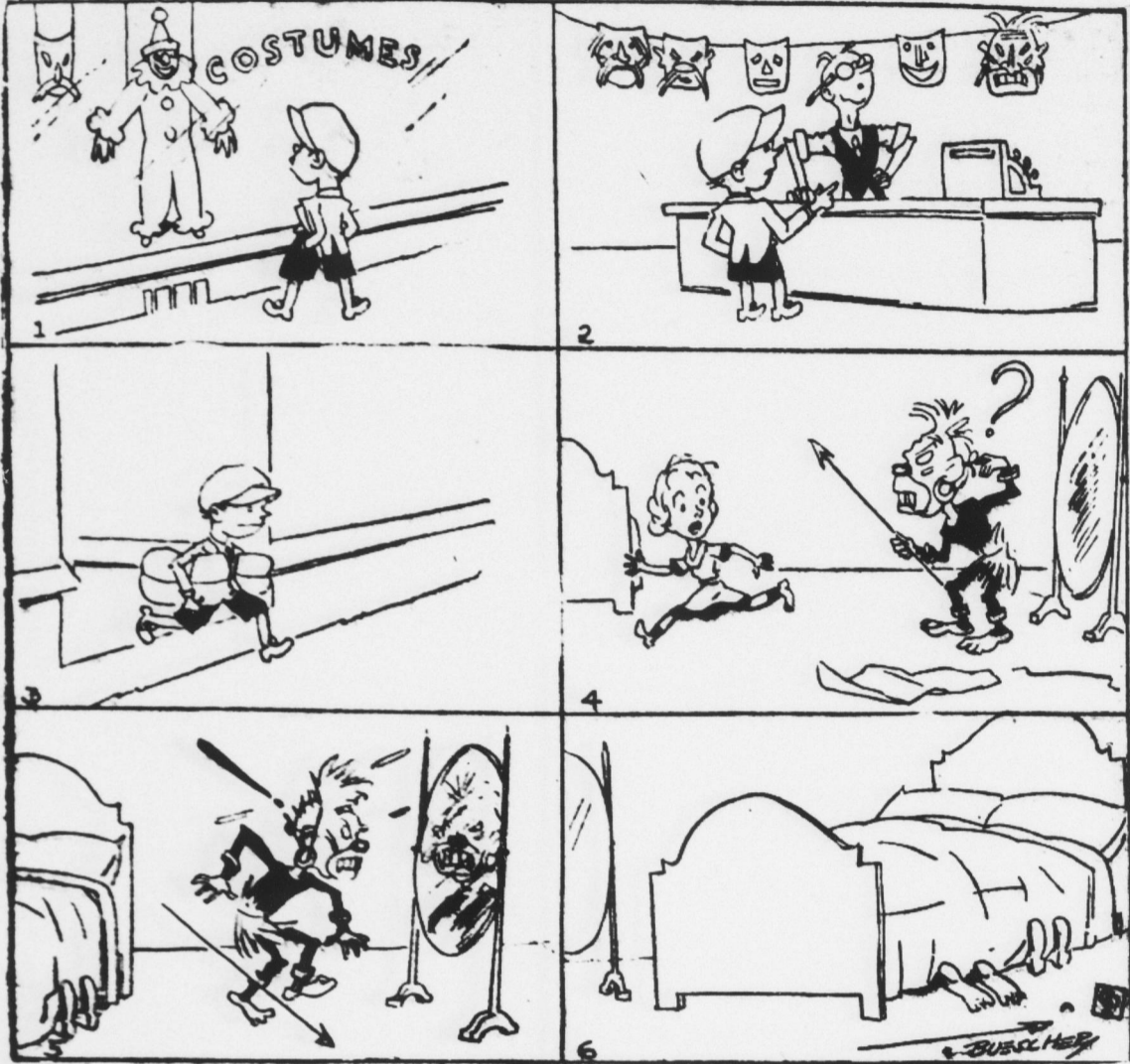

WARNS OF PEST ON STATE PECAN TREES

Raleigh, Oct. 31.—(AP)—Pecan growers noticing many fallen twigs and branches under their trees were warned today by C. H. Brannon, ex-

tension entomologist of N. C. State College, that the pecan twig girdler is causing unusually severe damage throughout the State this. Growers should collect and burn fallen branches or twigs both from the ground and those lodged in the trees, the entomologist said. In this way the eggs and larvae which will develop into mature girdlers next summer may be destroyed.
