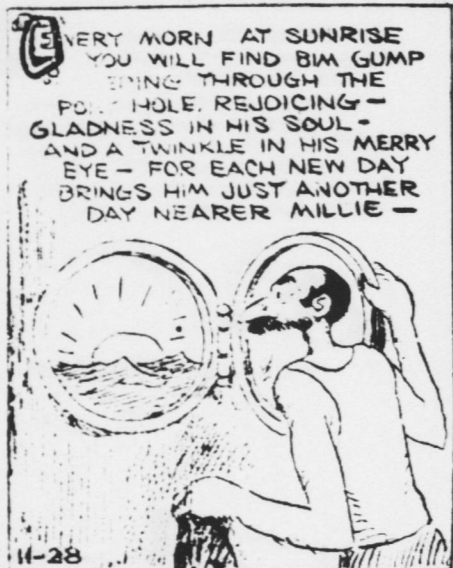

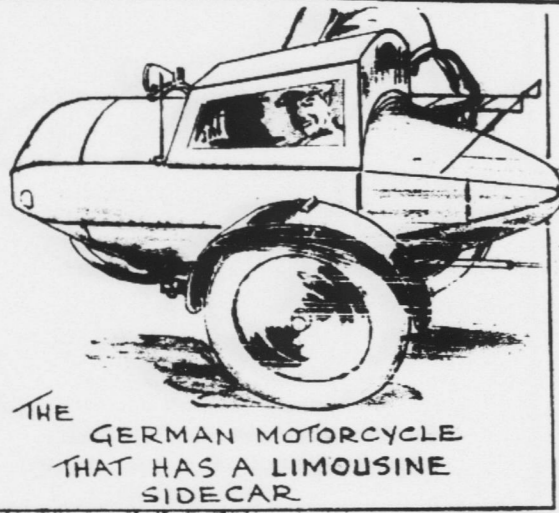

General Grand Master of United States To Be In Raleigh Next Monday Evening

Raleigh, Nov. 26 - General Grand Master Walter L. Stockwell, of the General Grand Council of the United States and past grand master of the Grand Lodge of North Dakota, will arrive here Monday afternoon, beginning a series of visitations to Masonic lodges in a number of southern states. He will be met here by distinguished Masons from both this State and South Carolina, some of whom will accompany him on his tour through South Carolina and on into Georgia. The Grand Council of North Carolina will assemble at 3 o'clock Monday afternoon to officially welcome him. Monday night at 7:30 o'clock, General Grand Master Stockwell will address the three Raleigh Masonic lodges on the subject, 'Freemasonry; What of

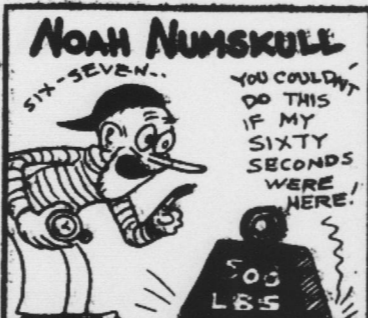
the Future?' In addition to the members of the Raleigh Masons from other lodges in all sections of the State have been invited and are expected to be present.

General Grand Master Stockwell was State superintendent of public instruction in North Dakota from 1883 to 1911, as well as past grand master of the North Dakota grand lodge and is well known in Masonic circles throughout the United States. He is coming here direct from his home in Fargo, North Dakota, to start his tour of the southern states.

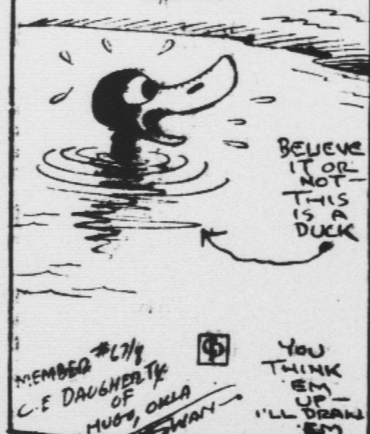
BLACKWOOD AND LEE AT TEXTILE BANQUET

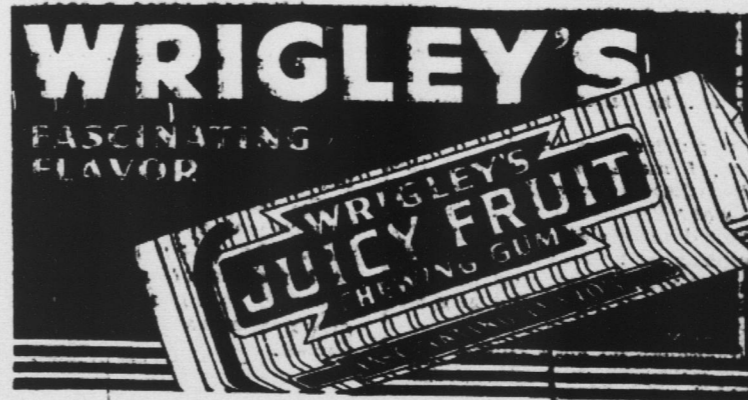
The 12th annual meeting of the National Association will be held here December 2 and 3.
