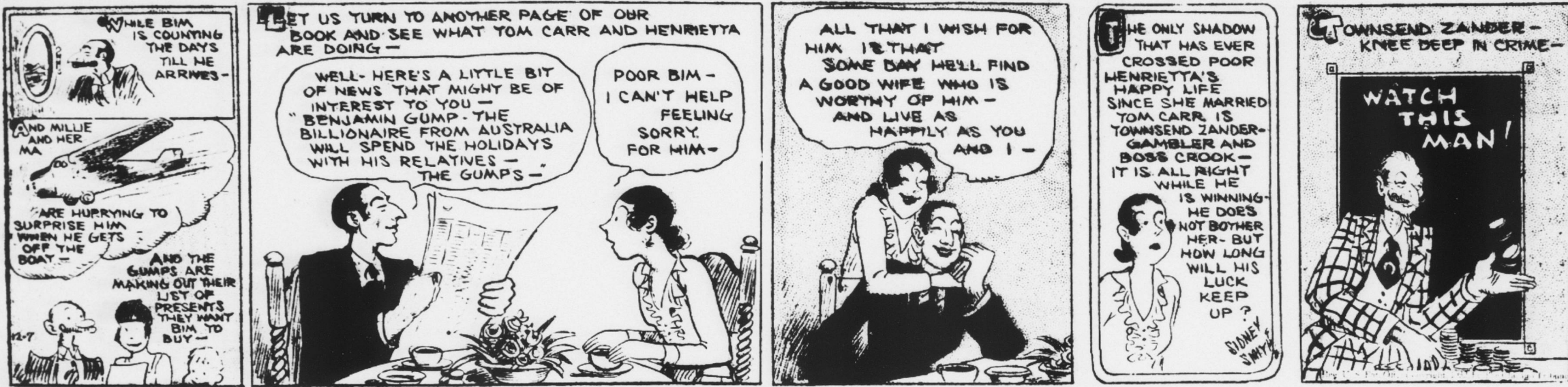

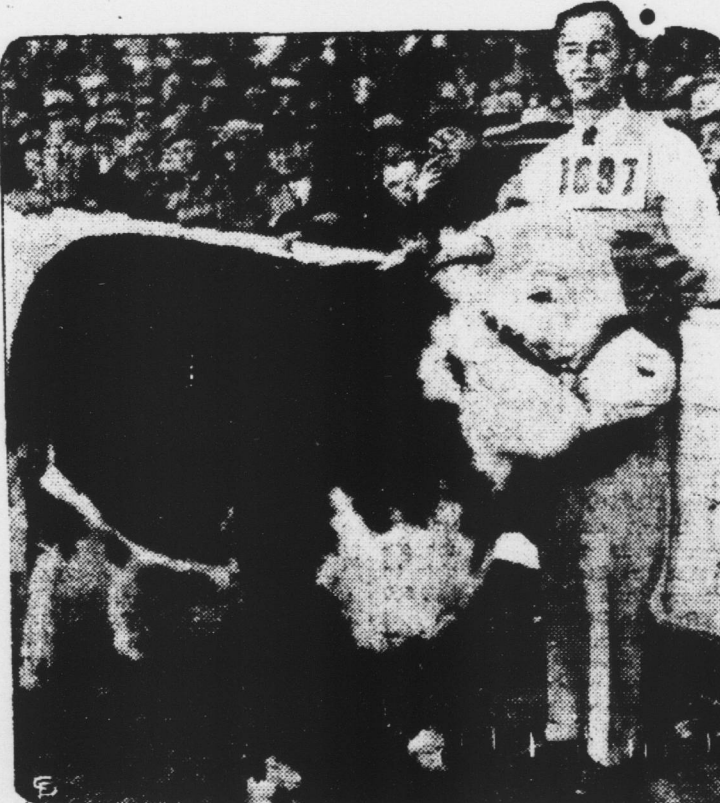

MEET THE KING OF CATTLEDOM!

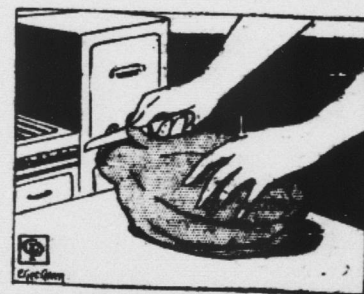
