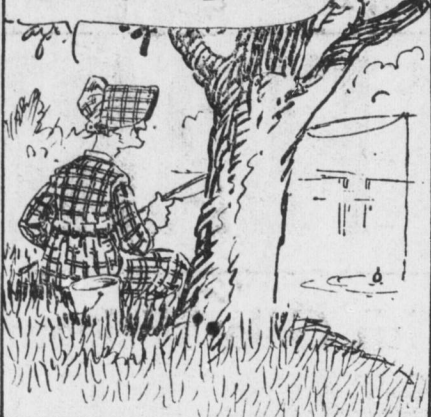

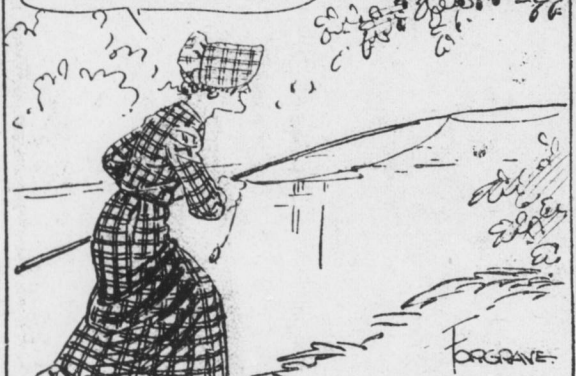

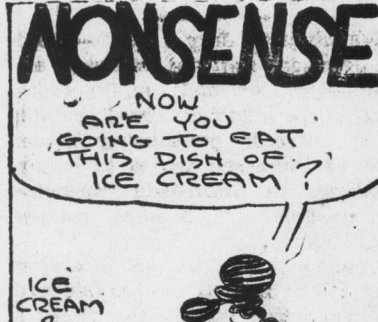

No State License To Hunt, Fish In National Forest

In the Sir Walter Hotel, Daily Dispatch Bureau, Raleigh, July 7. - The State of North Carolina has no legal right to declare that hunters and fishermen indulging in these sports on national forest lands in the state shall purchase State hunting and fishing licenses and a law setting up this requirement enacted by the General Assembly of 1933 is invalid, according to an opinion received by the Department of Conservation and Development from the solicitor of the U. S. Forest Service and made public today. The statute passed upon by the forestry solicitor constituted the second clause of a law of 1933 which sought to direct that funds allotted to the State from national forest receipts be used in the general funds of counties to which they were distributed instead of for schools and roads as specified by act of Congress. This phase of the law was also ruled inoperative by the U. S. Forest Service solicitor until Congress makes provision for a different use of the funds. Under the ruling referring to the right of the State to charge hunting and fishing licenses for privileges on national forests in North Carolina, the solicitor held that these rights passed to the Federal government under State acts authorizing purchase of the national forest lands.

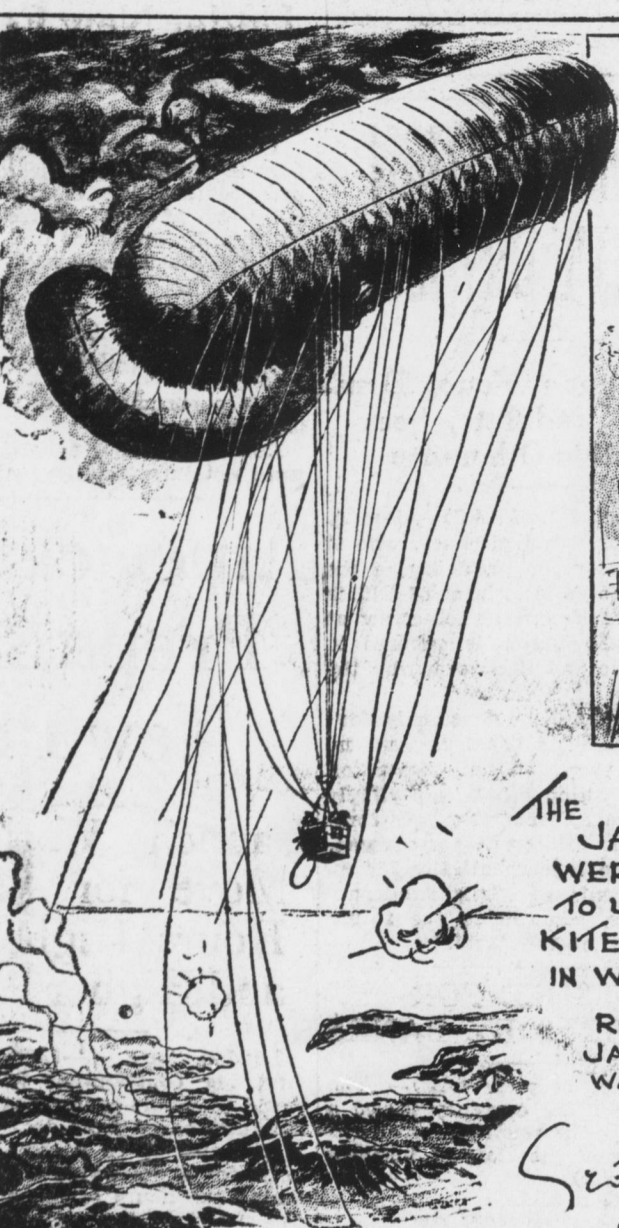
