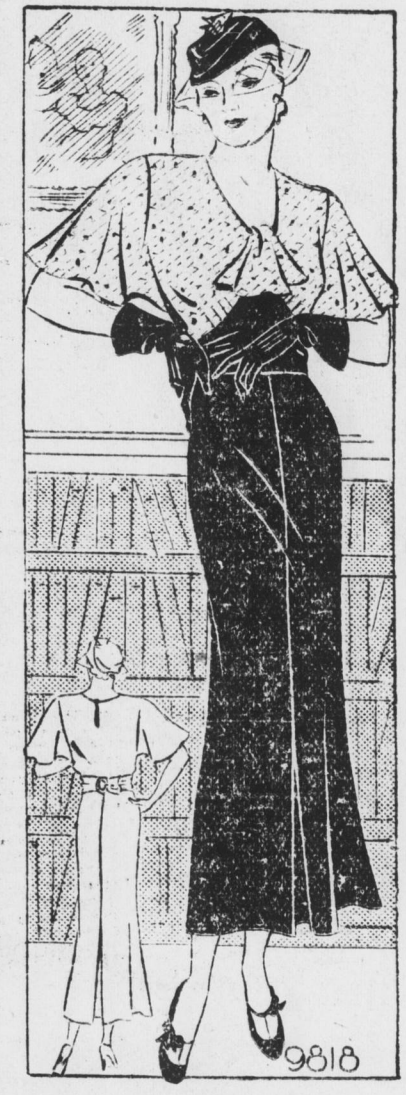

Up to December 1, as many of the able-bodied men and women now on relief lists will be transferred to Civil Works projects. But after that date, all of those given jobs on Civil Works projects will be enrolled entirely on the Reemployment Service lists. Not only should all unemployed, both unskilled and skilled, register at once with the reemployment service officers but those who are only temporarily employed, are also eligible for registration. It was pointed out, at the present time approximately 55,000 unemployed are registered with the Reemployment offices in the State, but Director Wayne does not believe this number represents all the unemployed.
