Monarchist Ruling Austria Once Hitler Aide



Prince Ernest von Starhemberg, 35, now ruling Austria as chancellor, is an avowed enemy of democracy. He was an aide of Adolph Hitler in the beginnings of Nazism in 1933, but he now is a foe of German and Austrian union and a partisan of Archduke Otto, heir to the Hapsburg throne. The prince rose to power in Austria as leader of the Heimwehr (home guard), which he started by organizing 800 retainers in his feudal barony. (Central Press)

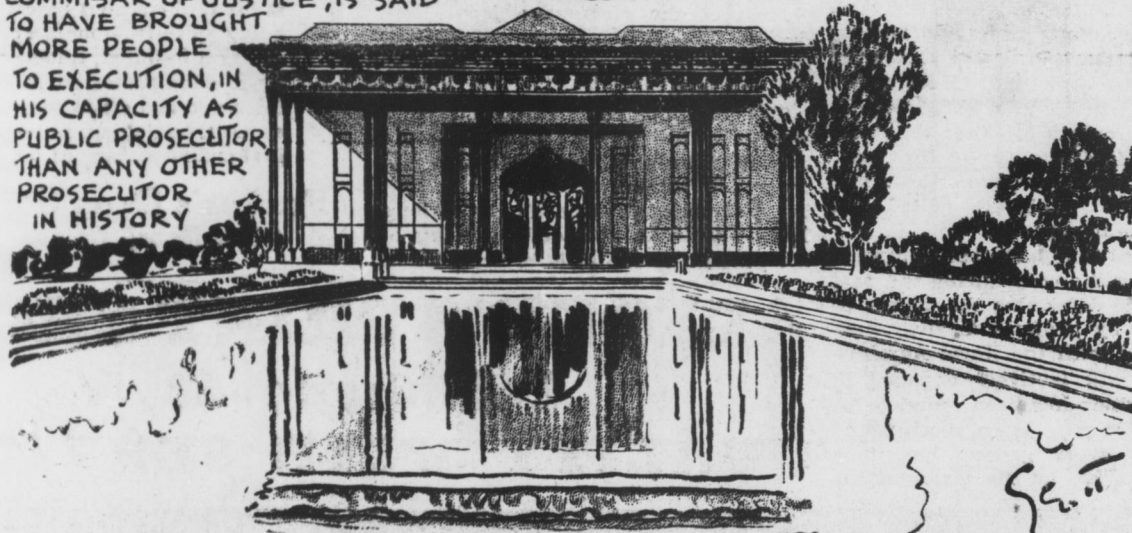

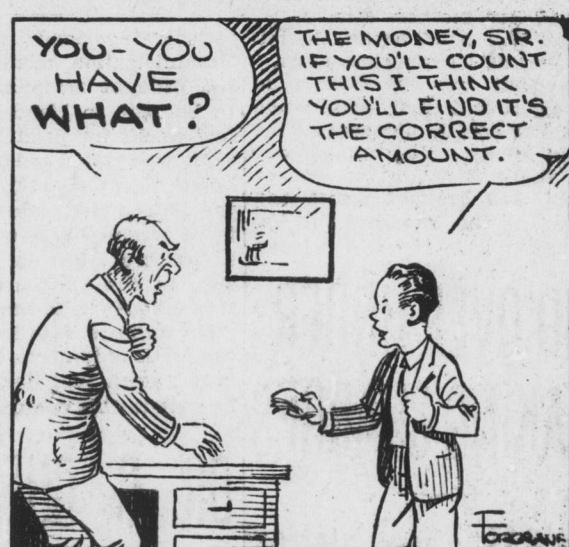

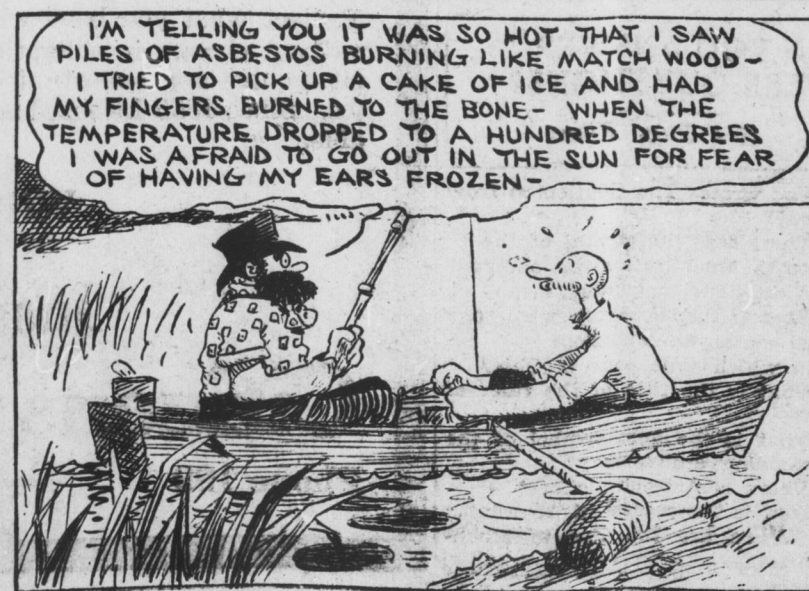
