The surface treatment gangs are now working in nine counties, as fol lows: Durham, Orange, Chatham, Randolph, Rockingham, Caswell, Guil ford, Davidson and Forsyth. Most of this is retreatment work, though some of it is new surfacing.

Betterment work is also proceeding rapidly on the county roads in 17 coun ties in this division. This work consists largely in grading and shaping the roads with tractors and road machines, in putting down sand clay or topsoil surfacing and in cleaning ditches, providing additional and better drainage, with new culverts and drain pipe. Much of this work is being done with prison labor, especially the ditching and drainage work. Much field stone is also being crushed and piled up for use on the county roads, especially in Warren, Durham, Granville and Orange counties. In Vance county, the reconditioning of the Dabney road has been started.




