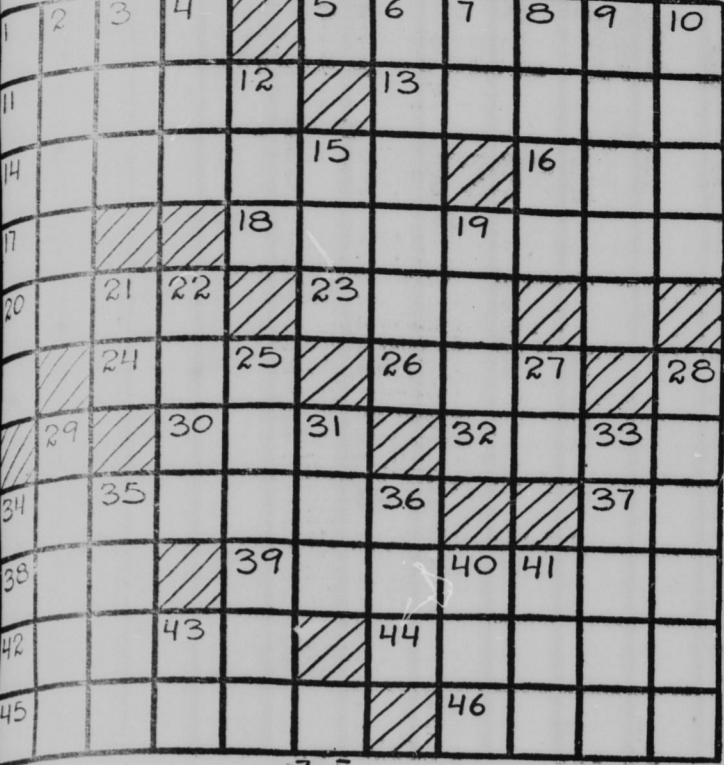


DAILY CROSS WORD PUZZLE

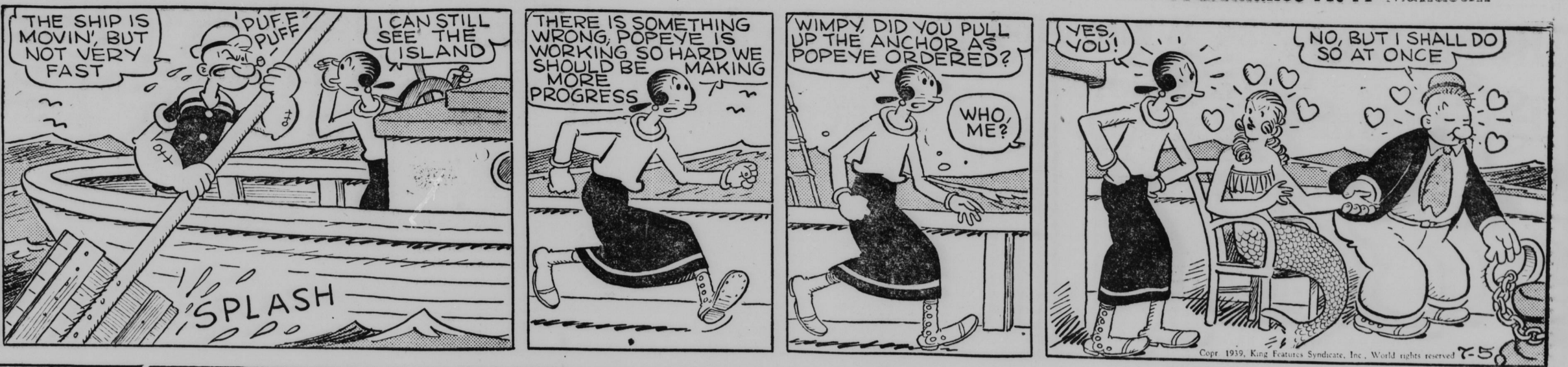

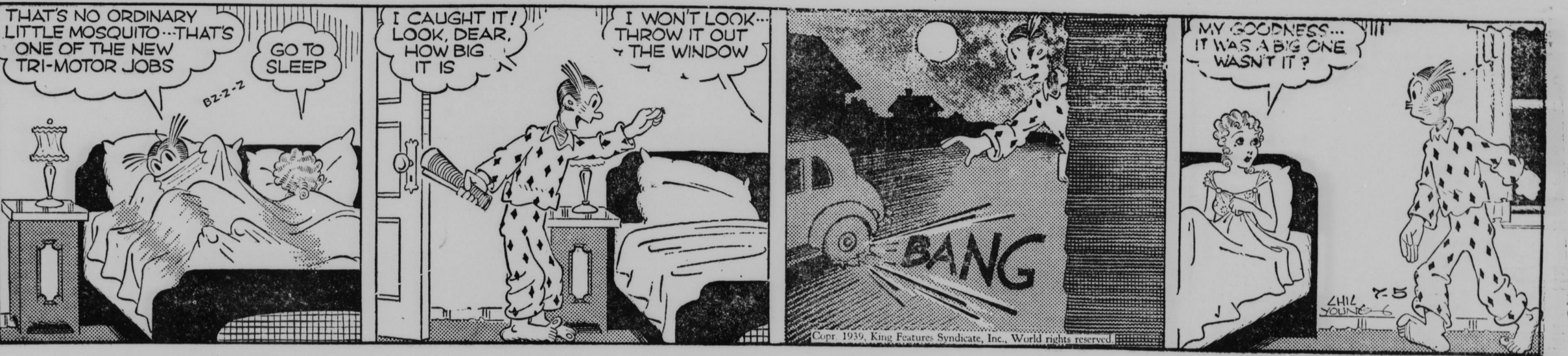

Called "THE OVERCOAT" MANY OLD-TIME bridge players call the spade suit "the overcoat" because it can cover any declaration during the bidding. The value of it is never more greatly emphasized than when opponents make a sacrifice bid a grand slam against you when your side has a grand slam in the hands. If their suit happens to be spades there is nothing you can do but then play at their sacrifice whereas if your suit is clubs you can take the bid away from them and score your big game.
