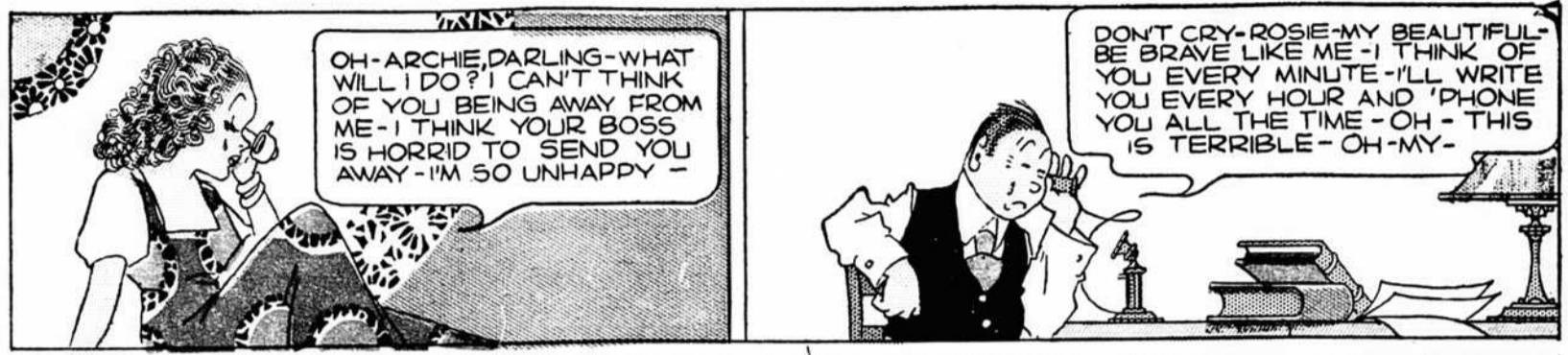

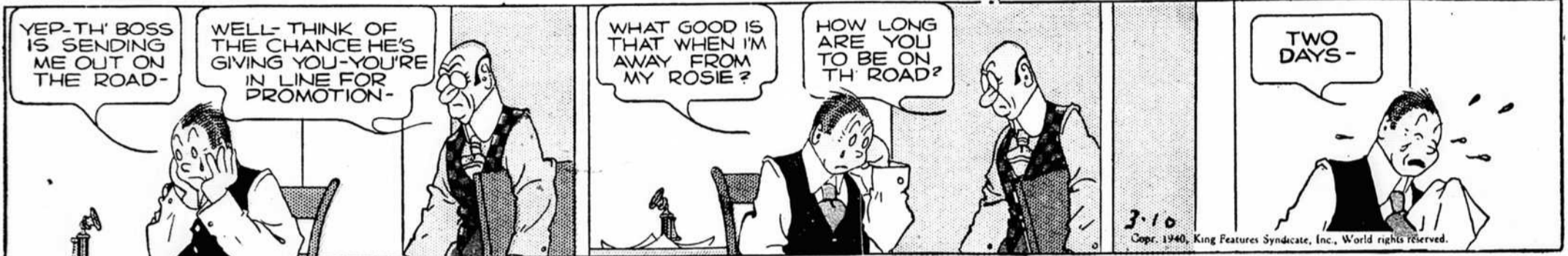

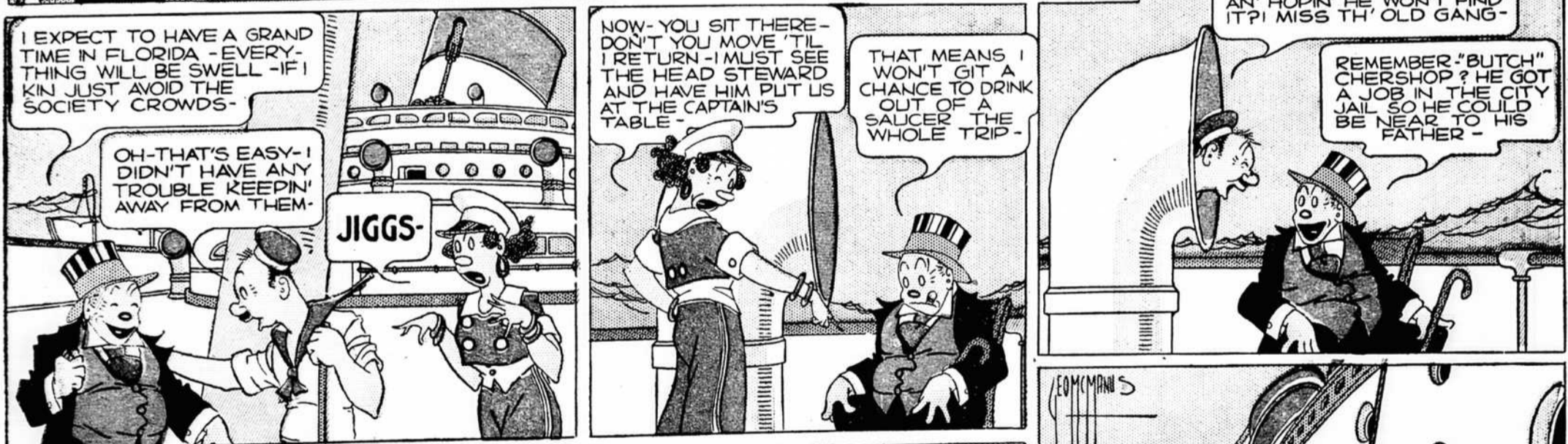
I WONDER IF DUGAN STILL HAS HIS OLD PLACE IN TAMPA?
