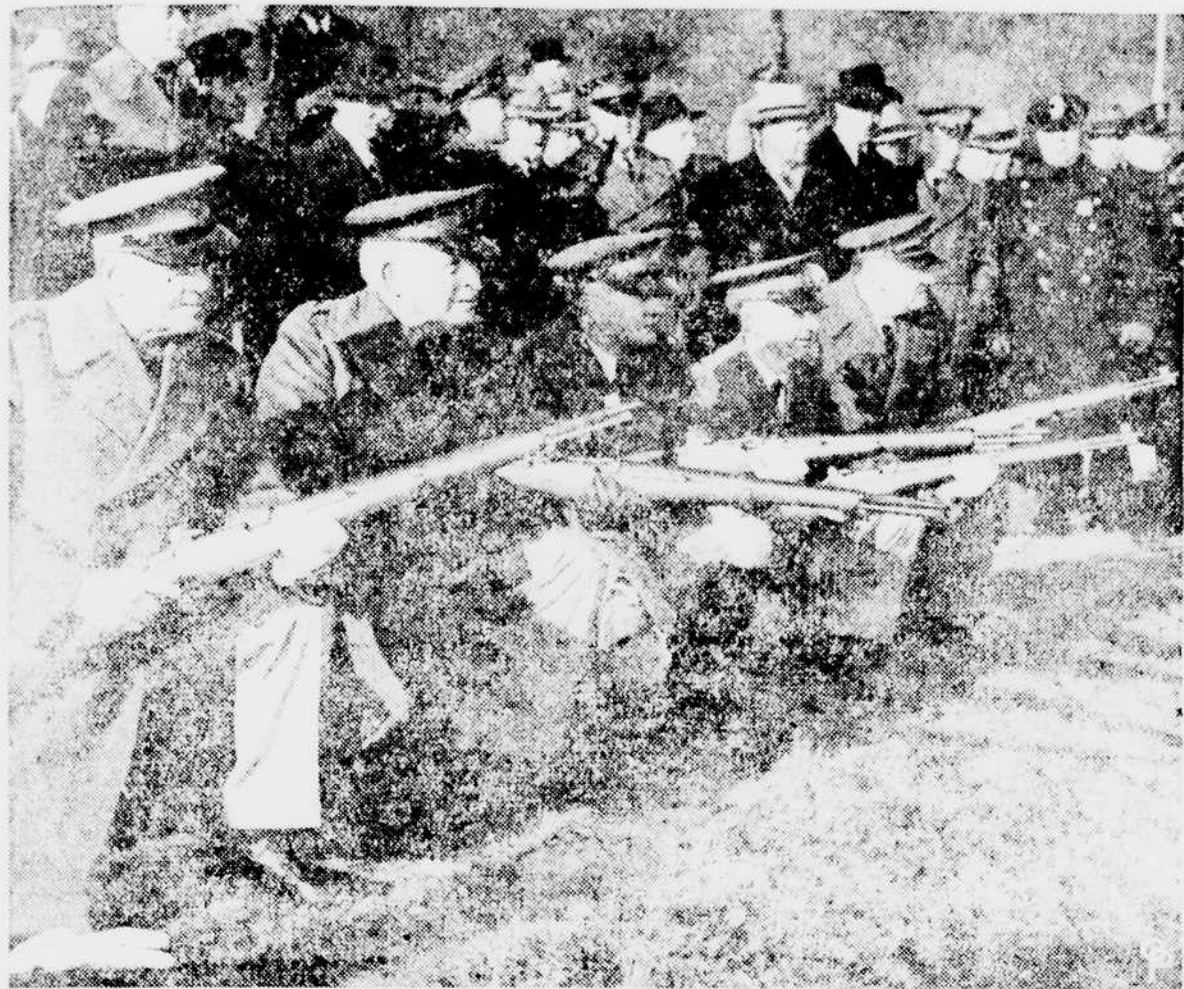

### Raids Range From Coast To Venice

London, Jan. 12 (AP)—Day and night attacks on both Axis forces, ranging from the coast of France to the Channel coast, were reported by the air ministry today.

Night raids, it said, hit the harbor of Brest, Le Havre and Lorient, and at all targets of the Channel coast. It said the German city of Bremen and the Dutch port of Rotterdam were also hit.

The night attack on the German coast ended yesterday, the ministry said, but it was reported that an attempt to land on a beach near the coast was repulsed by the British.
