Hospital Versus the Home for Childbirth

In one of my recent columns I questioned the wisdom of sending any woman to a hospital to have her baby. I said that I could do a better job with a few minutes' practice than I could myself in giving you a woman's reasons for choosing. I know my own doctor would have preferred for me to stay at home for both other confinements, mostly for his own convenience, as it is 15 miles to the hospital and only 2 to my home.

The Doctor's Letter
"I want to go on record as authorizing you to give your patients the best possible care. I have always felt that the possibility of confinement in a hospital is less in the home than in the hospital."
I do not believe that the hospital offers a superior or other facilities for such a thing as pregnancy should be provided at home. In my experience, the mothers are more comfortable in their own homes with more privacy. They are not bothered by the noise and other inconveniences of even the best conducted hospitals, to say nothing of the expense.
"In a recent number of *Hogan* the average fee for a delivery in a hospital was put down as between \$75 and \$250. My average expense to a family is now, as it has been for twenty years, in the neighborhood of \$25, and I frankly don't see how most people can afford to pay \$250."
