WILLY BAER TOPPLED LOUS OVER THE ROPES



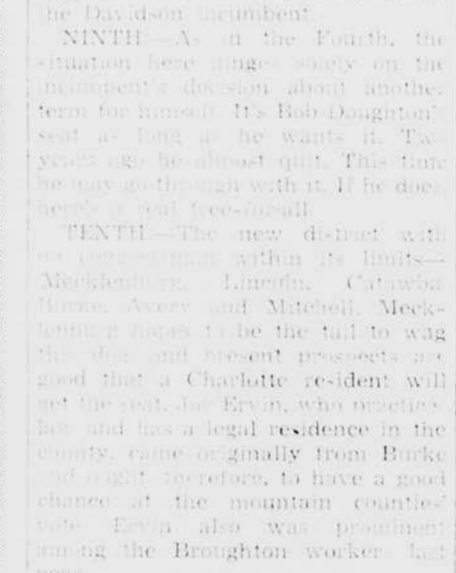
Willy Baer, world heavyweight champion, is thrown over the ropes by Lou Thesz in the first round of their match at the Washington, D. C. arena.

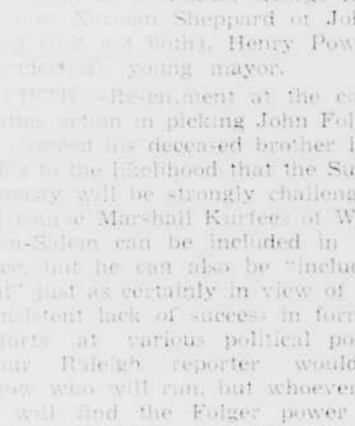

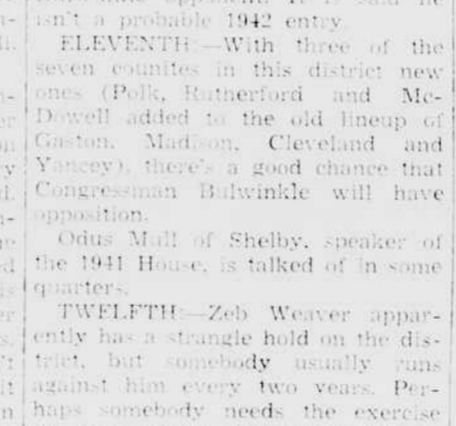

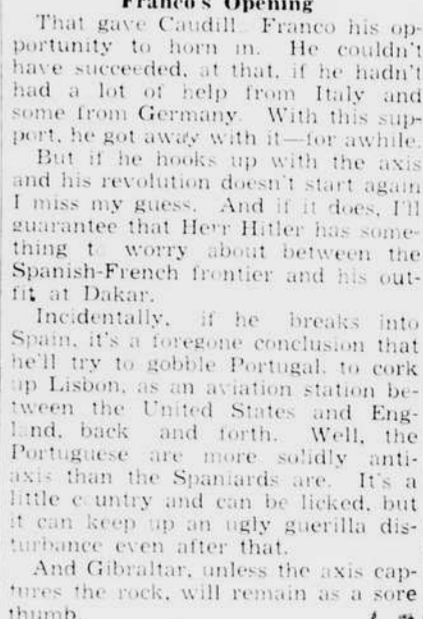

But if he hooks up with the axis and his revolution doesn't start again, I miss my guess. And if it does, I'll guarantee that Herr Hitler has something to worry about between the Spanish-French frontier and his outfit at Dakar.

Incidentally, if he breaks into Spain, it's a foregone conclusion that he'll try to gobble Portugal, to cork up Lisbon, as an aviation station between the United States and England, back and forth. Well, the Portuguese are more solidly anti-axis than the Spaniards are. It's a little untried and can be licked, but it can keep up an ugly guerrilla disturbance even after that.
